God placed them in Eden

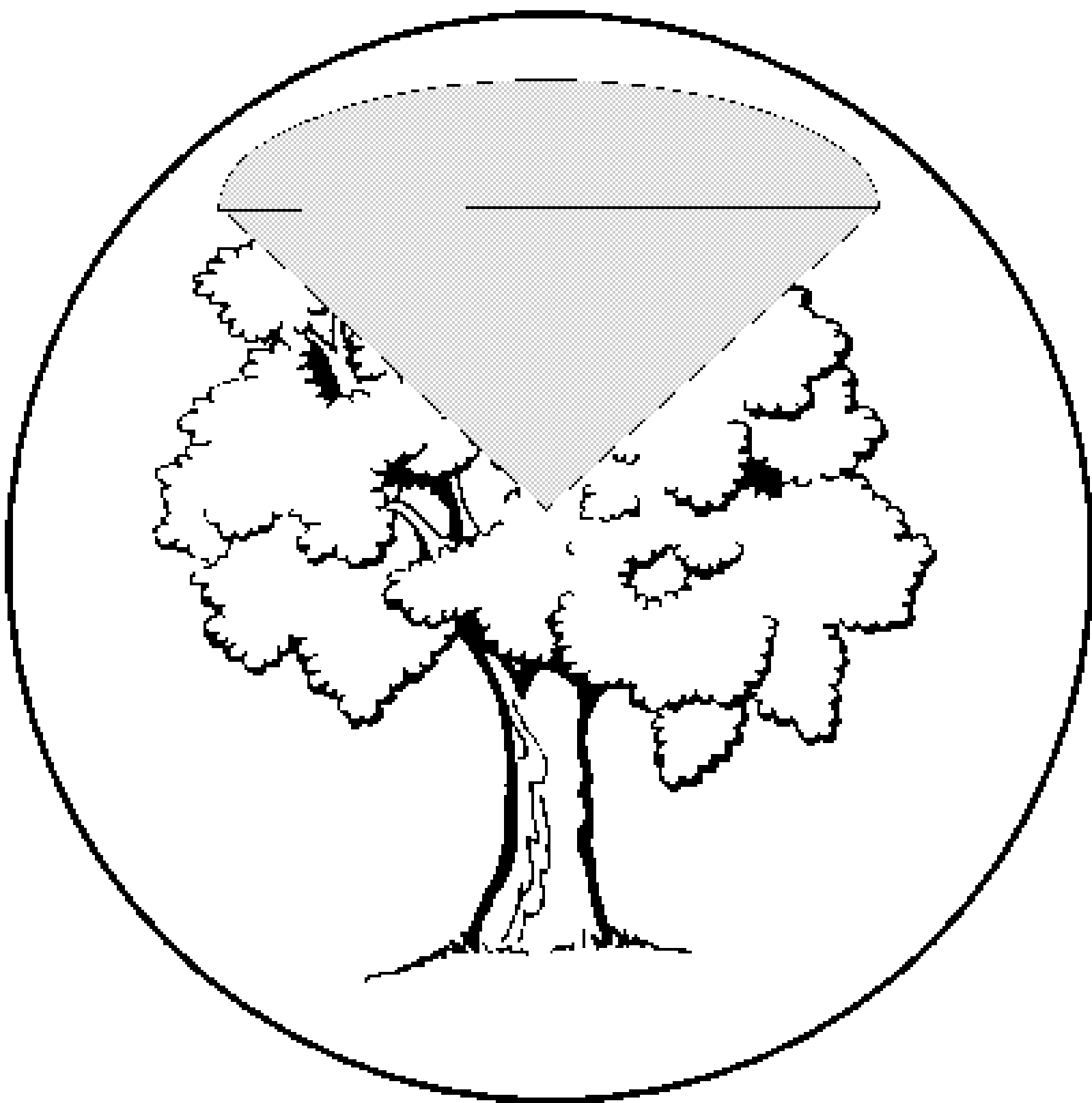
But please don't touch the tree

Oh, please don't touch the tree

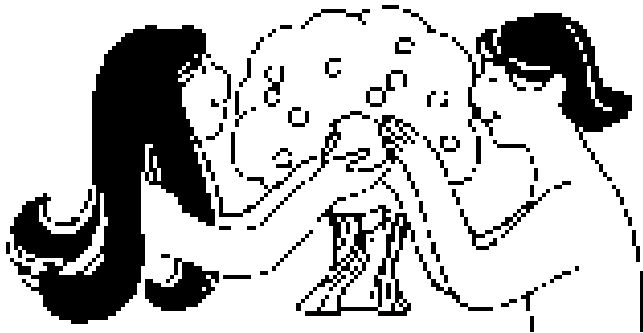
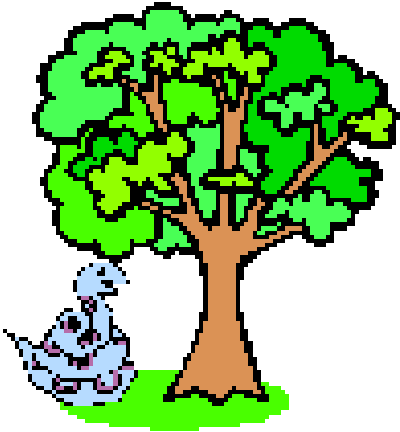

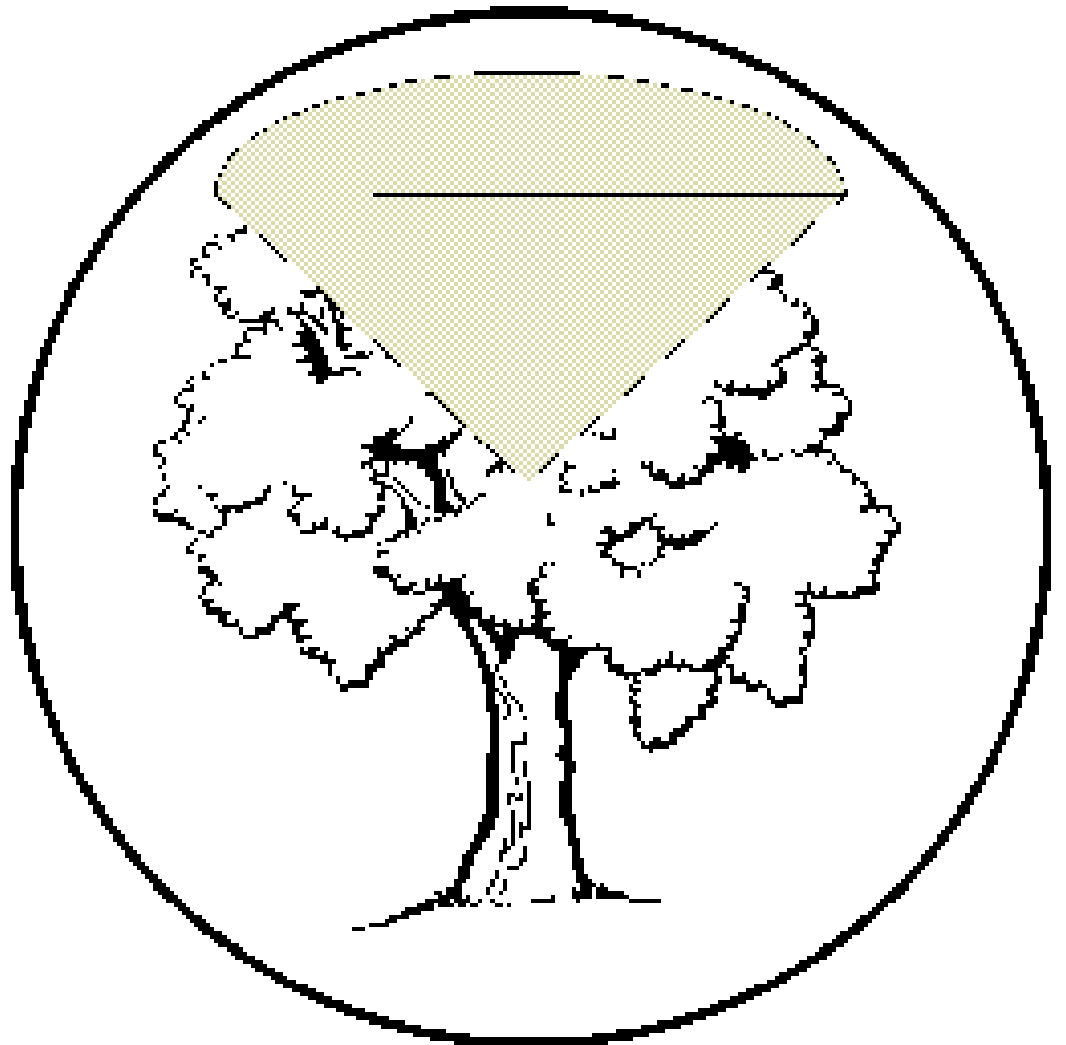
Eve ate forbidden fruit

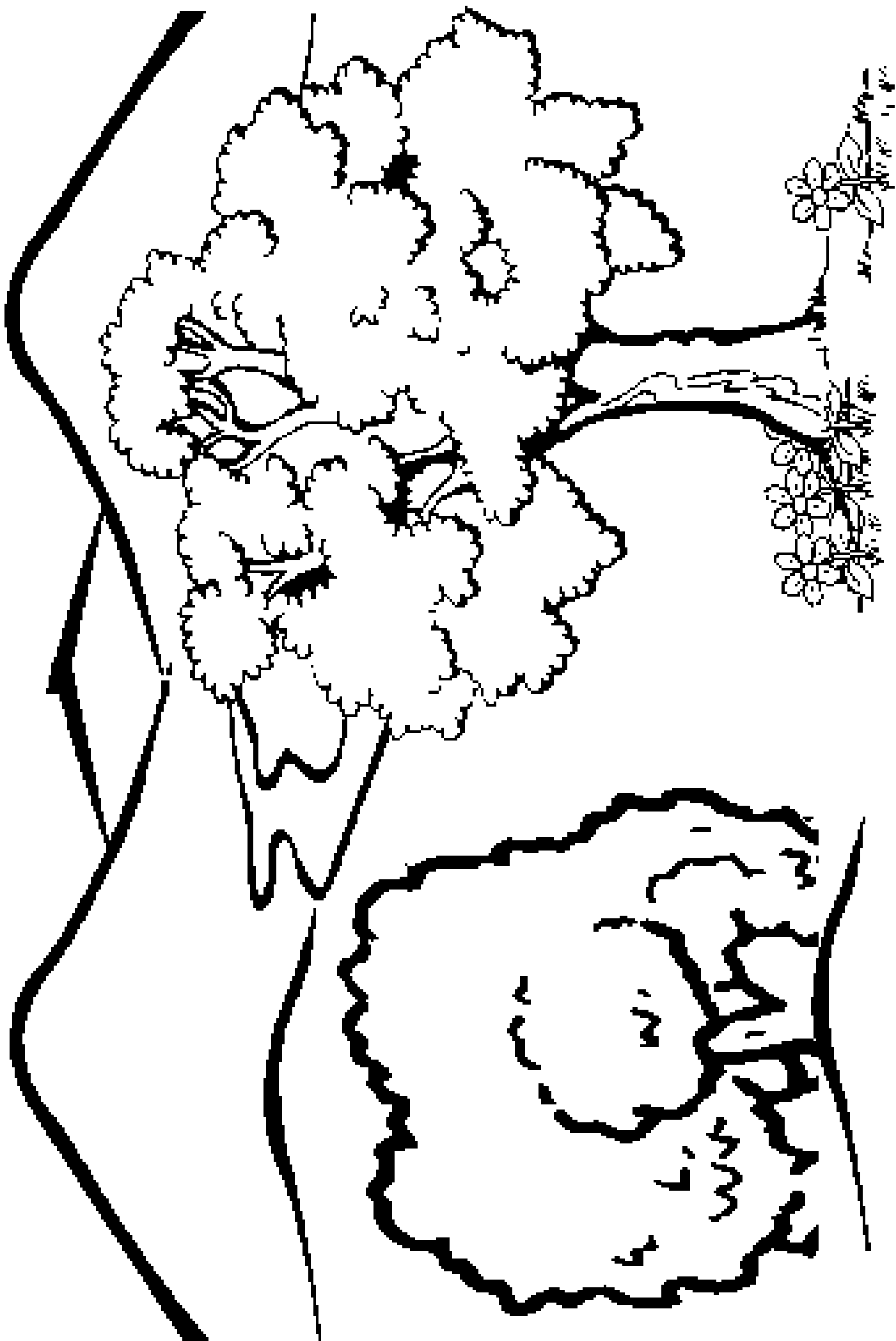


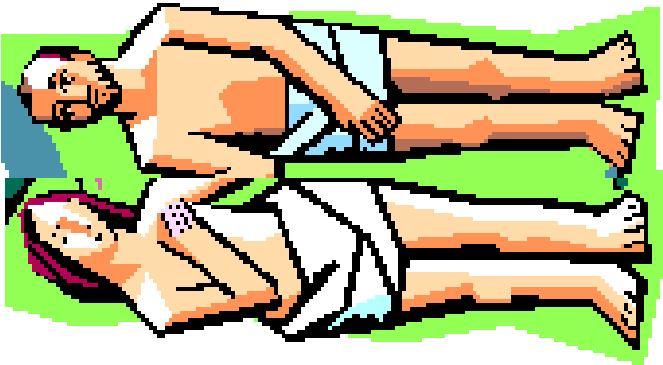

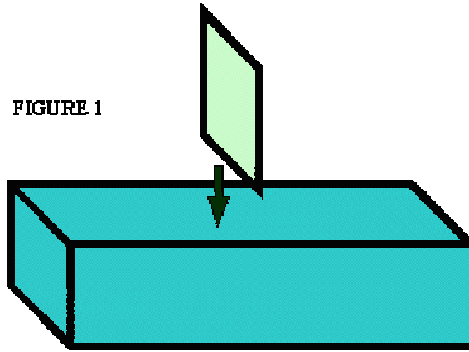

Garden Diarama (Shadow Box)

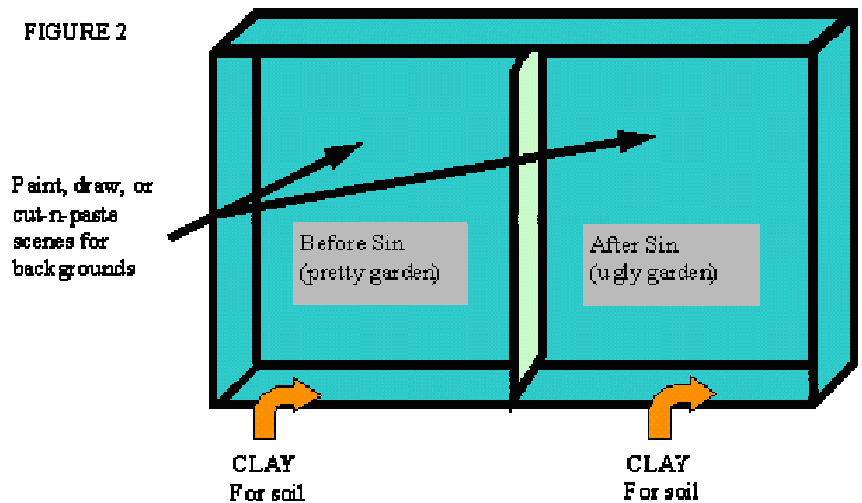
1. Divide your box into half by cutting a piece of cardboard the width of the narrow side and glue or tape it across the middle to make two separate compartments (Figure 1).



2. Turn the box on its side making one side the bottom. Put the brown clay (or play-dough) in the bottom of both sides (Figure 2).

3. On one side make neat, straight rows of plants (using the tines of your fork for furrows). This is to represent the time before sin in Eden. On the other side make the garden not so neat and add small twigs and rocks (after sin, outside of Eden).

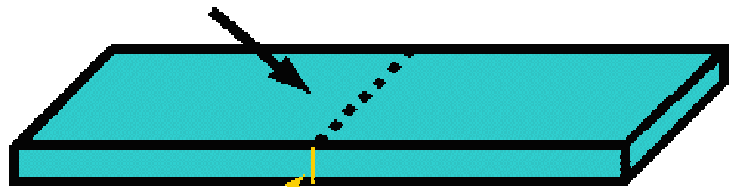

4. Snip the edges of the lid (see Figure 3) and then fold the lid in the middle so it will act as a "hinge." Set the lid back on your box and now your diarama is complete!

The idea is to keep one side of the diarama covered while you explain the other. In this lesson on the first sin use the shadow box to explain the "consequence of actions."

Fold lid in the middle to make a "hinge" so you can display one side at a time.



Cut the edge on both sides of the lid.
