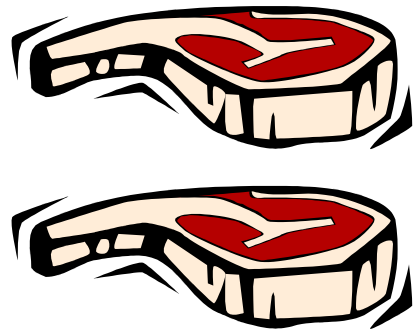
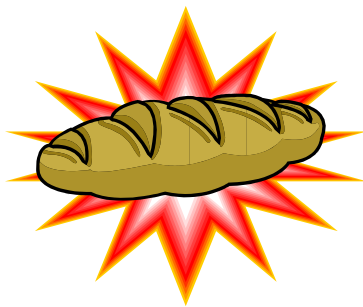
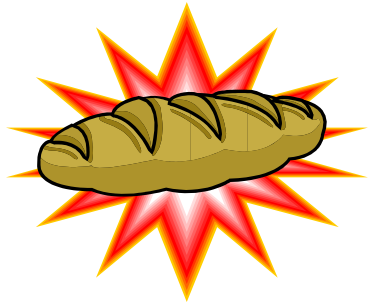

according to the word of the Lord which He spoke by Elijah”

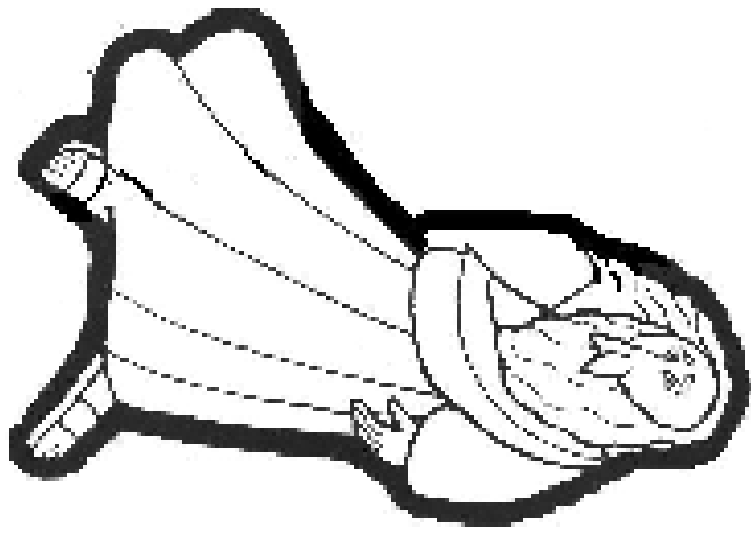






Glue boy from waist down only so the Widow's son can sit up when Elijah prays for him.
