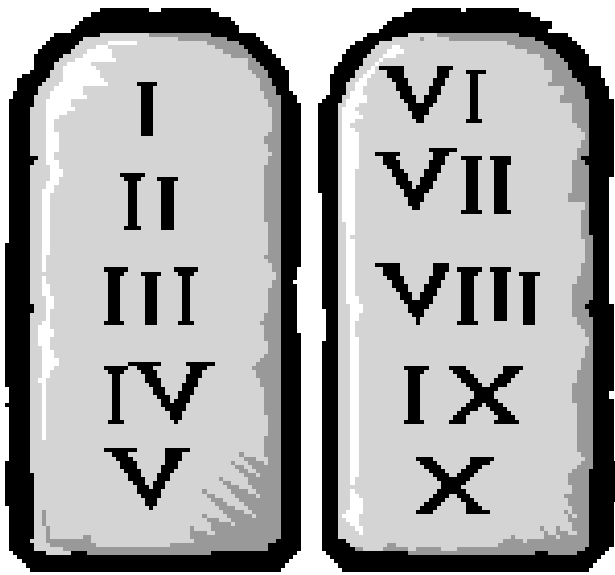

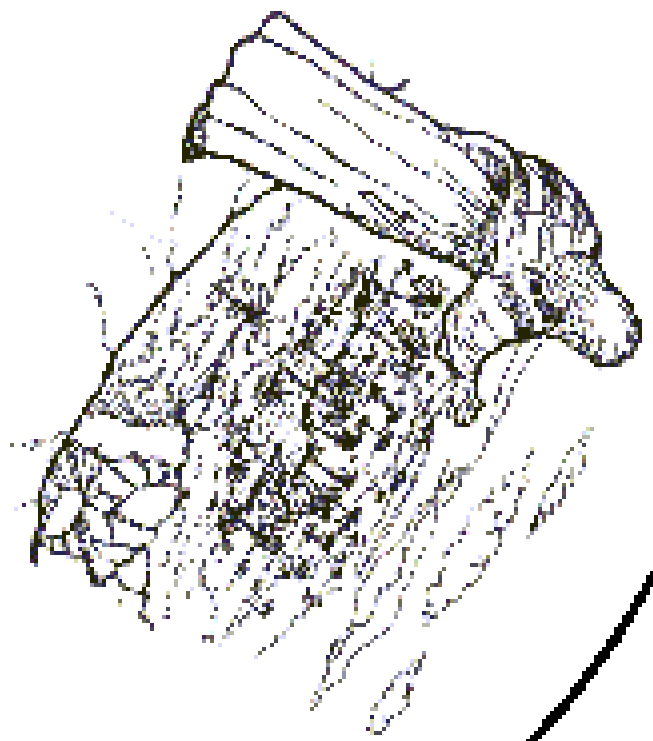


Moses hits the rock instead of talking to it as God told him to. He is punished by not being allowed to enter Canaan.
