Brass Serpent
Numbers 21:4-35

After God gave the people water from a rock in Kadesh, the people of Israel traveled on to Mt. Hor. God called Moses, Aaron and Eleazar to the top of Mt. Hor and told Moses to take the High Priest's clothes from Aaron and give them to Eleazar, Aaron's son. When Eleazar had the High Priest's clothes Aaron died.

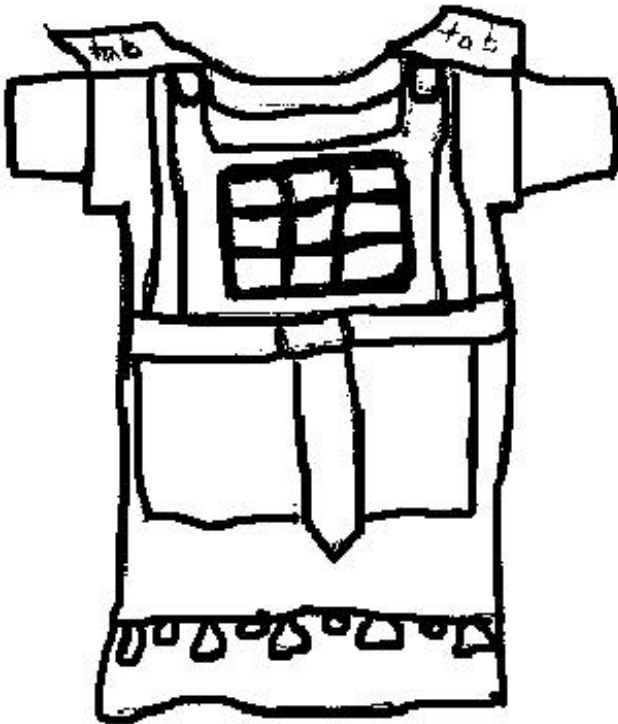
The people stayed at Mt. Hor for a month to mourn Aaron's death then traveled around the land of Edom. Along the way the people began to complain AGAIN, saying "Why have you brought us out of Egypt into the wilderness to die. There is no food and no water here. We are SO TIRED of this yucky manna!"

This time God did not have Moses speak or hit a rock to bring water. God did not send a gigantic flock of quail. God sent fiery snakes! These snakes were so deadly that if someone got bit they died. When the had snakes bit many, many people and they came to Moses and pleaded with him to pray to God to forgive them for complaining against Him and Moses.

God told Moses to make a serpent and put it on a pole and that anyone who was bitten could look at the snake would not die but be well again. So Moses made a snake out of bronze and put it on a pole and everyone that had been bitten and looked at the bronze snake lived.

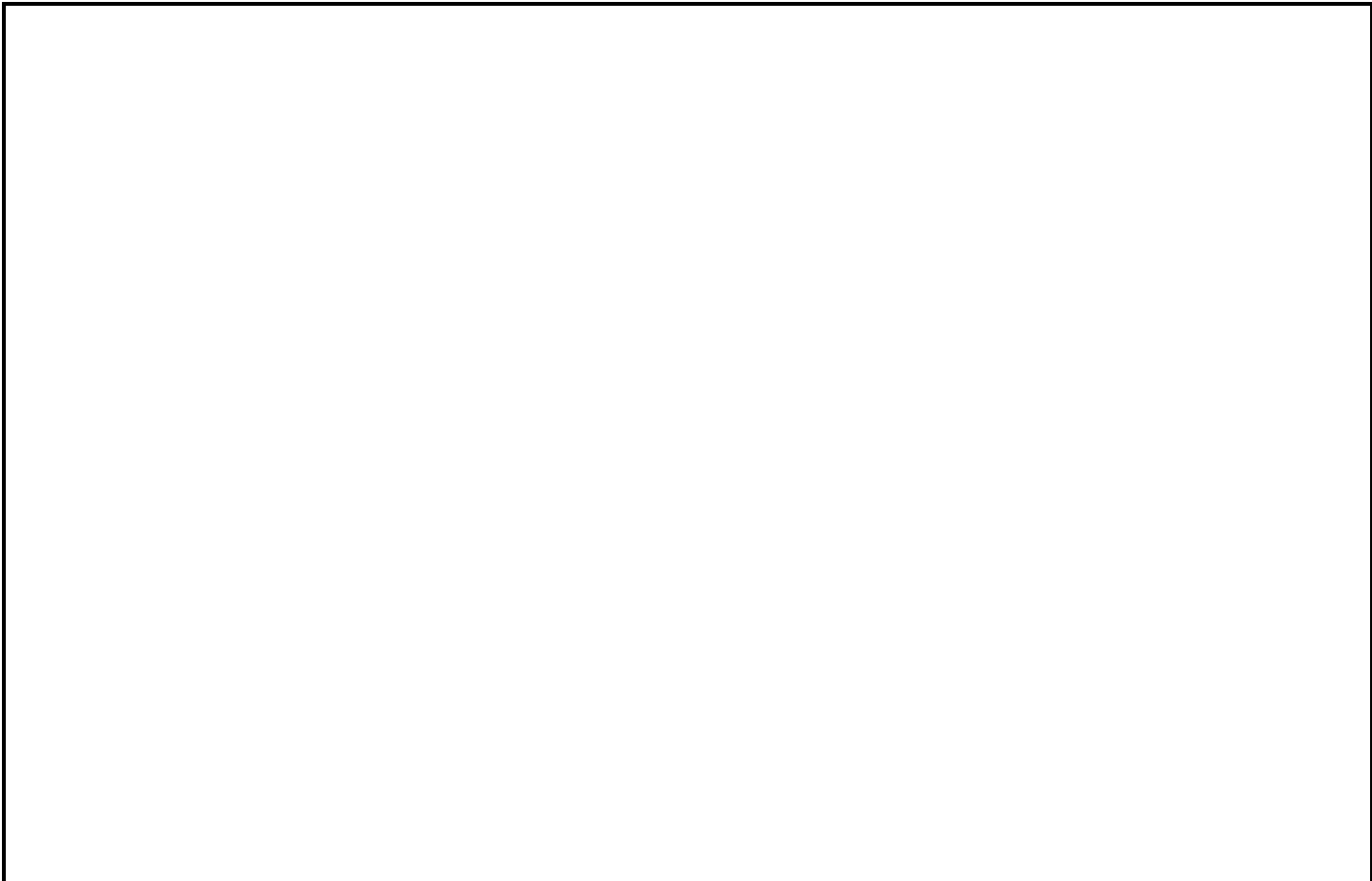
The children of Israel moved on from there to Moab and their entry into the promised land of Canaan begins by defeating Amorite King Sihon and King Og of Bashan.

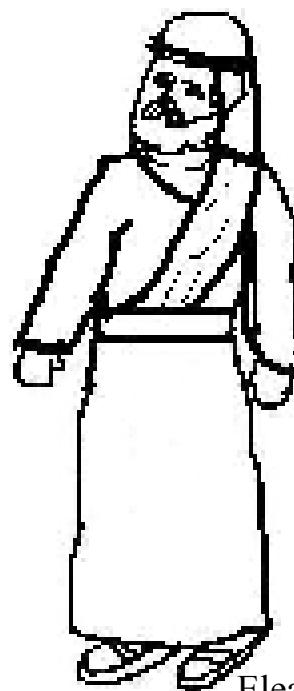


Moses took Aaron and Eleazar up on top of Mt. Hor. There God told them to take the High Priest's Clothes from Aaron and put them on Eleazar.

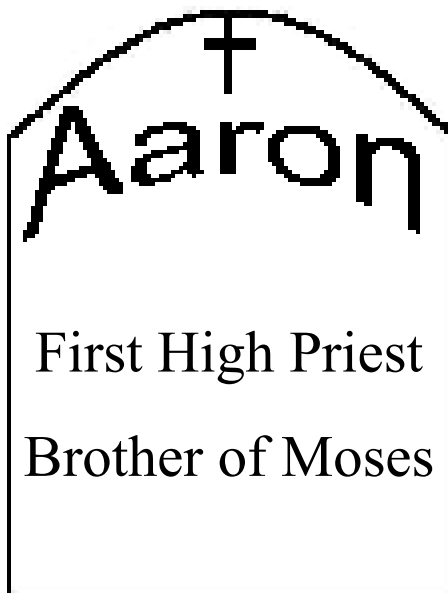
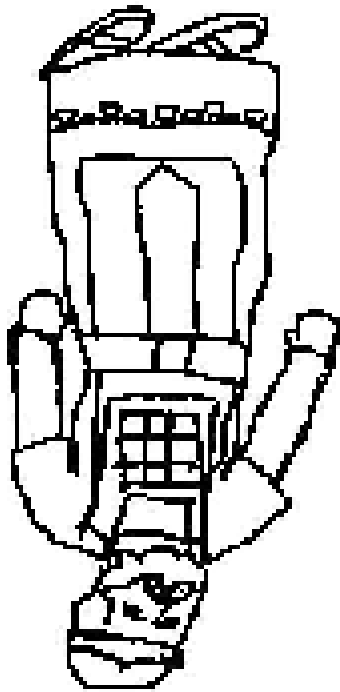
