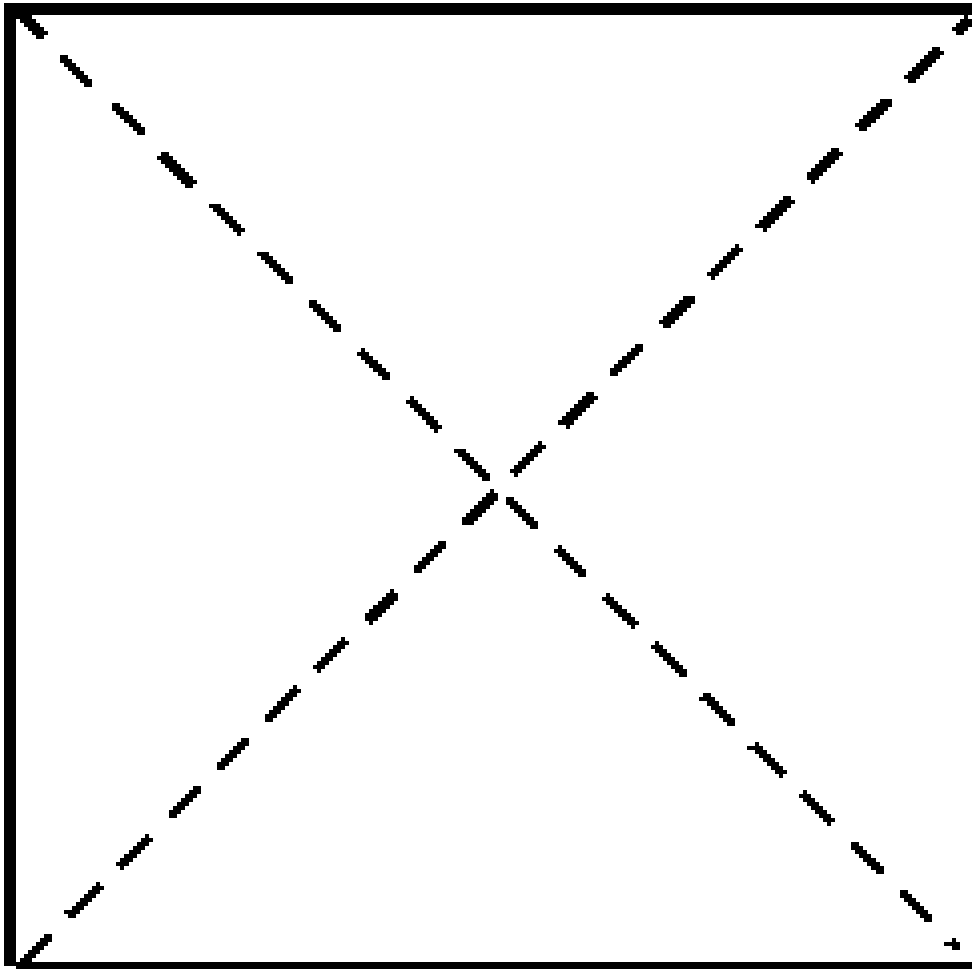


Numbers 23-24— Use own Bible Story book, or Paraphrase from the Bible

Lesson	Tactile Time	Take-home
<p>Read Introduce Story—Tape record each student making an animal noise before class. Teacher tapes “What have I done to you?” Play before lesson asking who says ____? Ask who says “What have I done to you? I’m going to tell you about an animal who did...”</p> <p>Focus: Balaam was greedy</p>	<p>Felt/fabric pull string bag with "gold" and "silver" coins. (make coins by covering cardboard circles with aluminum foil or colored craft paper or use toy coins)</p>	<p>Coin bag explosion book (pp 2-3)</p> <p>For younger students make and give each student a cloth/felt bag like used in tactile time.</p>

<p>Read:</p> <p>Focus: Balaam Blesses Israel</p>	<p>Building blocks to build 7 alters, toy cows and sheep</p>	<p>Alters Pop-up (pp 4-5)</p>



Before class—page 5


1. Cut along solid line.
2. Fold corners to opposite corner, crease, open back up. ()
3. Fold top down to meet bottom, pushing sides in on the previous fold lines.
4. Fold each corner into the inside to form a “house” shape

Before class—page 6

5. Print on brown paper, color, or use as template to cut from construction paper; fold along dotted line.
6. Cut out coins for each child
7. Glue inside bag shaped cover point side to the bottom

In class:

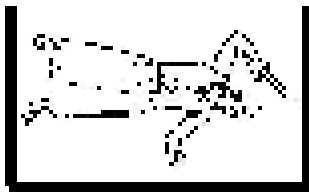
7. Glue “coins” inside of bag. Glue a piece of string on each side along “bag neck”, if desired.

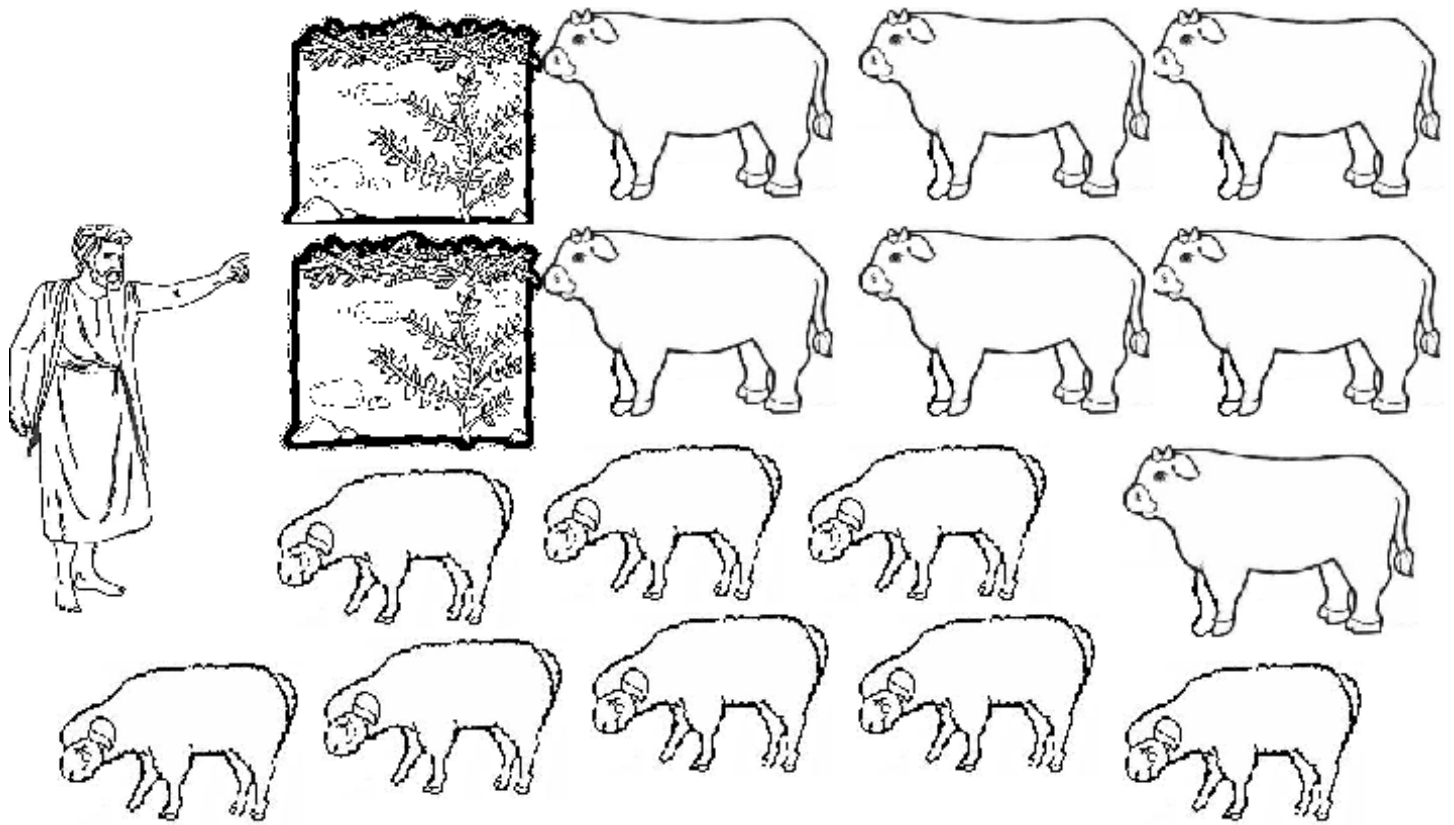




King Balak took Balaam to Kirjeth Huzoth and there offered oxen and sheep and gave some to Balaam and the princes with him
