<p>Read:” Jacob and Esau”</p> <p>Focus: Isaac prays and God answers with birth of twins.</p>	<p>Hold twin baby dolls</p>	<p>Birth of Esau and Jacob book—(pg 2-3) Fold page in half, help the children two glue paper pockets on to the sheet and slide a “baby boy” into each one</p>
<p>Read:” Jacob and Esau”</p> <p>Jacob is a shepherd Esau is a hunter</p>	<p>“TV”</p>	<p>Jacob and Esau’s jobs—(pp 4-5) print page 5 on sticker sheet or cut out and glue deer on top half with Esau and the sheep on the bottom half with Jacob</p>

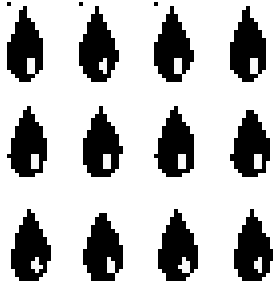

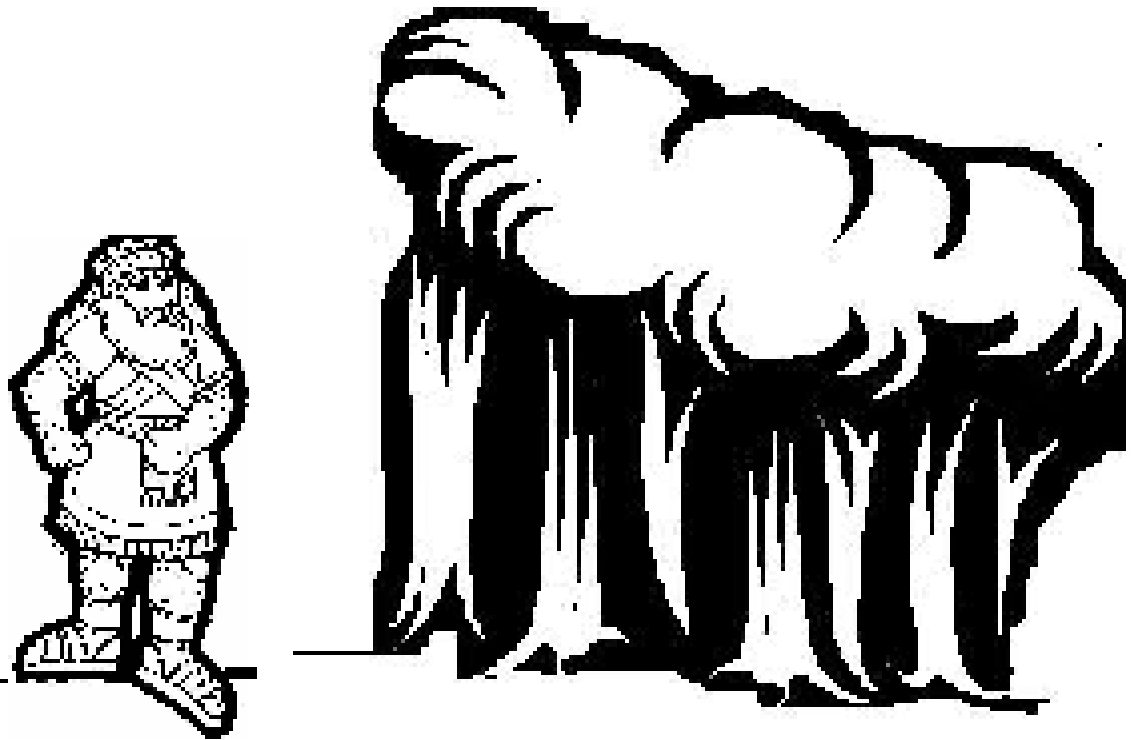
Before class:

In class:

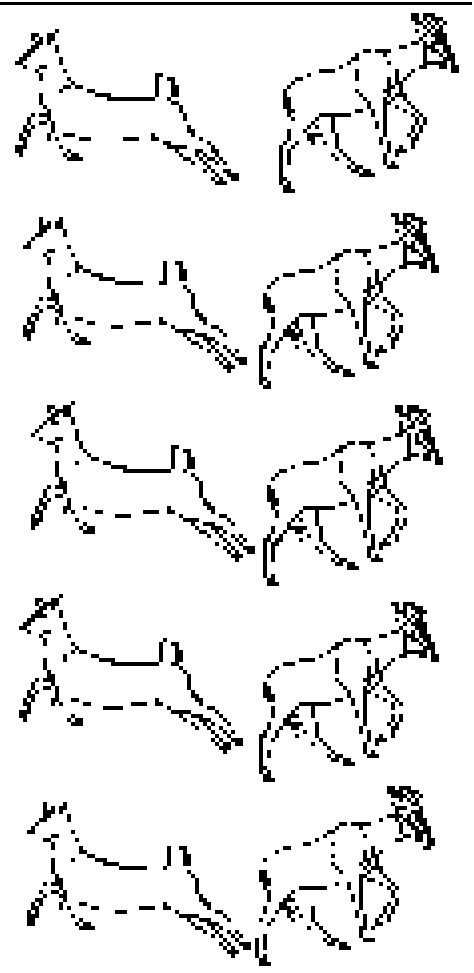
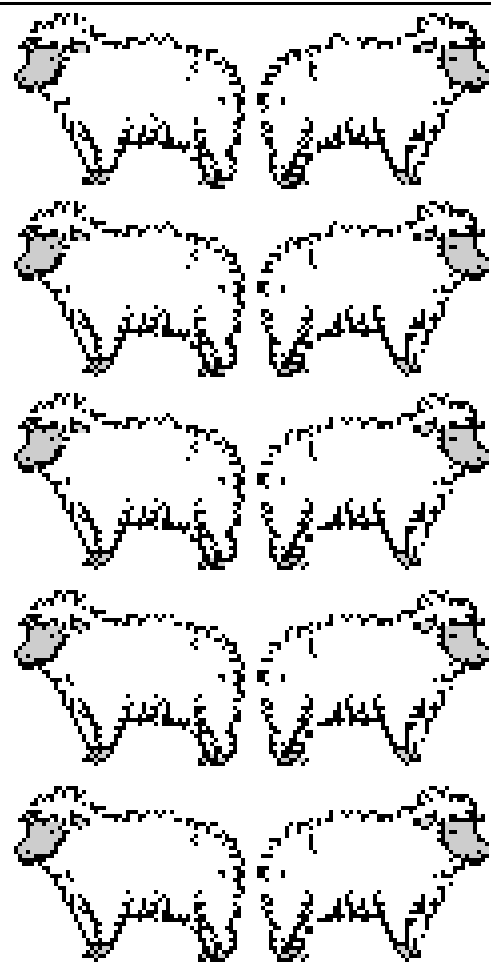
Slide a baby in each pocket.
