<p>Read Jacob Wants to Go Home Gen 29:31-31:21</p>	<p>Use “Barbie” and “Ken” dolls, action figures, or pipe cleaner people to demonstrate how many people there were in Jacob’s family</p>	<p>Glue 11 small boys, 1 small girl, 1 large boy, and 4 large girls on page 2. Color code the small boys and girl to match which mother if desired. (6 boys/1 girl—Leah, 2 boys each—Bilhah and Zilpah, 1 boy—Rachel). Use circle smile faces or cut paper doll chains and cut apart for people.</p>

Leah has 6 sons and 1 daughter, Zilpah, and Bilhah each have 2 sons and Rachel has 1 son.

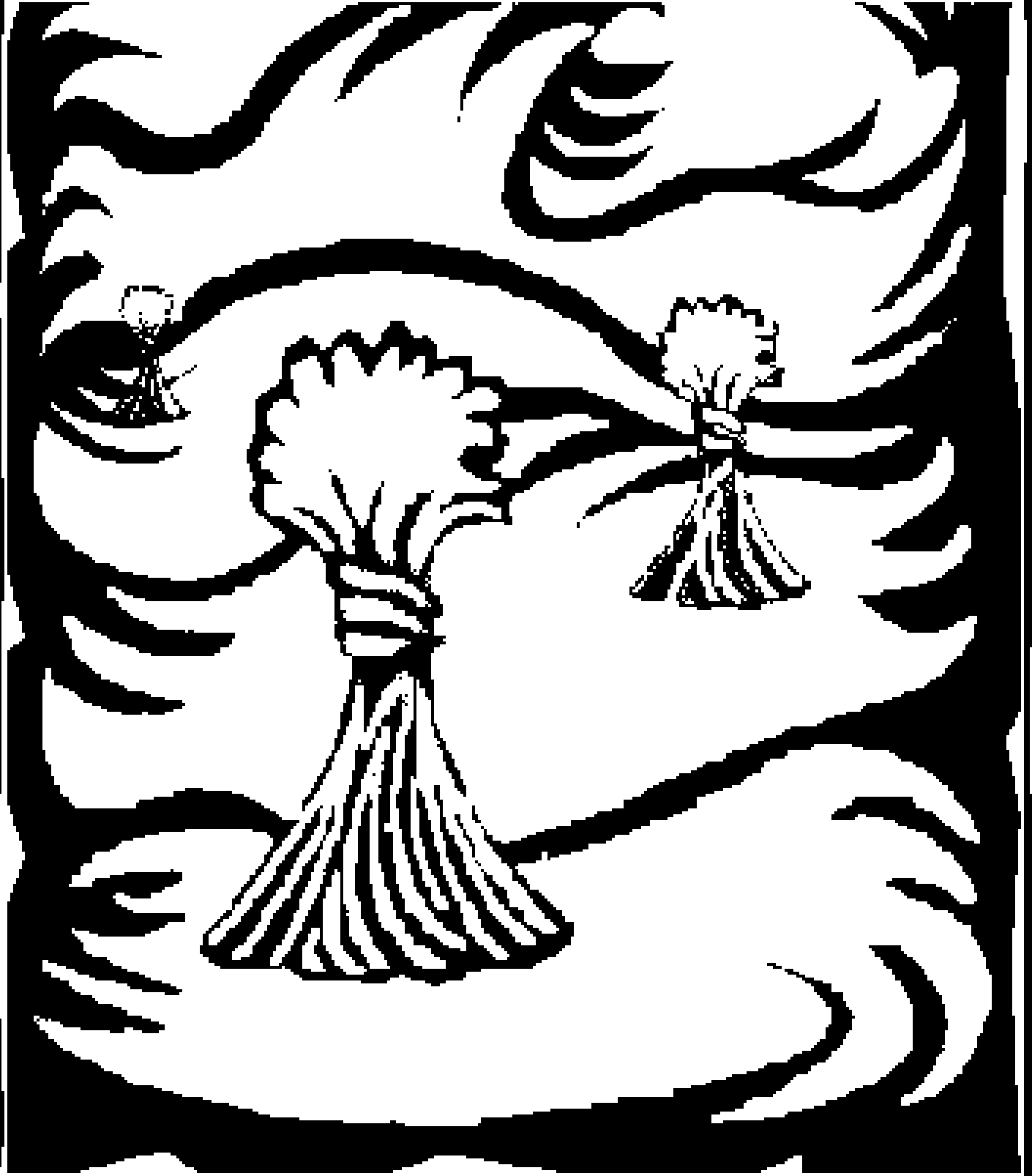
