<p>Read "Joseph in Potiphar's House" - Gen. 39</p> <p>Focus: Potiphar's wife lied and Joseph was thrown in prison.</p>	<p>Shoe box prison</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pipe cleaner/small action figure for Joseph, guard, other prisoners</li> </ul>	<p>Joseph in Prison (pp 5-6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut out window and along dotted lines on door.</li> <li>• Let the children tape pipe cleaners for bars across back of window.</li> <li>• Glue/tape picture of Joseph behind prison door.</li> </ul>
<p>Read "Joseph in Prison" - Gen. 40</p> <p>Focus: Butler's dream</p>	<p>Shoe box prison</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use figures from last week—Joseph, the Butler, and the Cook.</li> <li>• Enlarge and print off the grape vine, grape juice, and baskets pictures or use plastic grapes and stuffed birds or figurines and show above the prison when appropriate in story.</li> </ul>	<p>The Butler's dream (pg 7 &amp; 8)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Print page 9 on 2 1/2" round self-adhesive sticker printer paper or regular paper and cut out and glue)</li> <li>• Let children color the butler and stick/glue the grape vine and juice picture in the "dream" bubble on page 7.</li> </ul>
<p>Read "Joseph in Prison" - Gen. 40</p> <p>Focus: Baker's dream</p>	<p>Act out story</p>	<p>Baker's dream (page 9 &amp; 10)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Let children glue the person with the basket on his head and then 2 more baskets stacked on the first basket inside the "dream" bubble.</li> </ul>

and kept him from all harm.

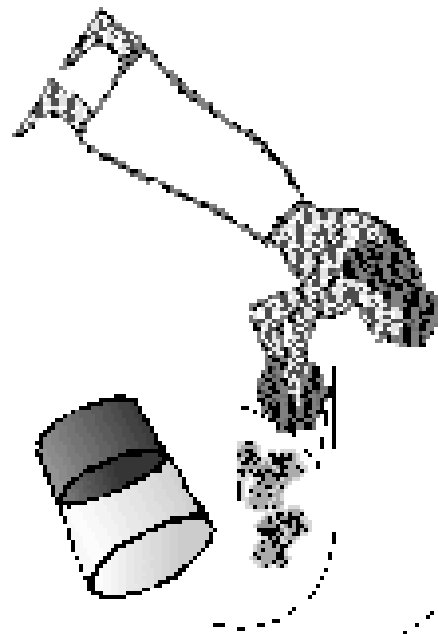
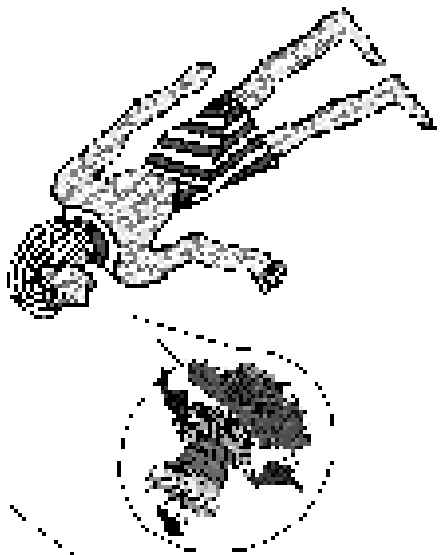
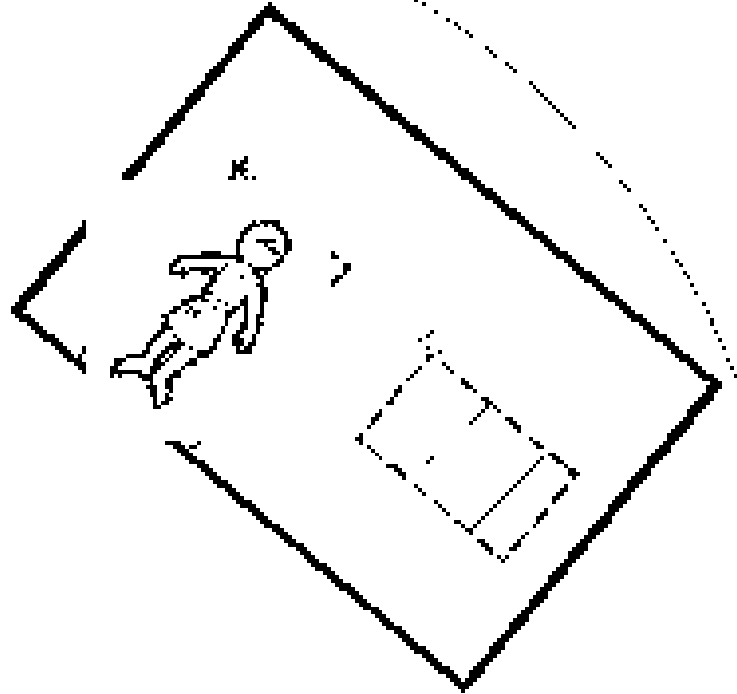
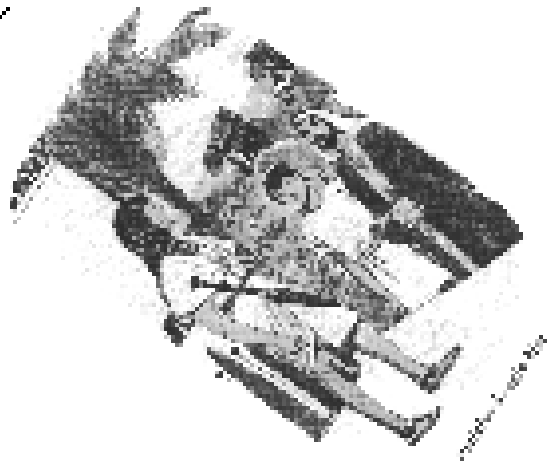
Twelve Tribes of Israel

Joseph, Gad and Benjamin.

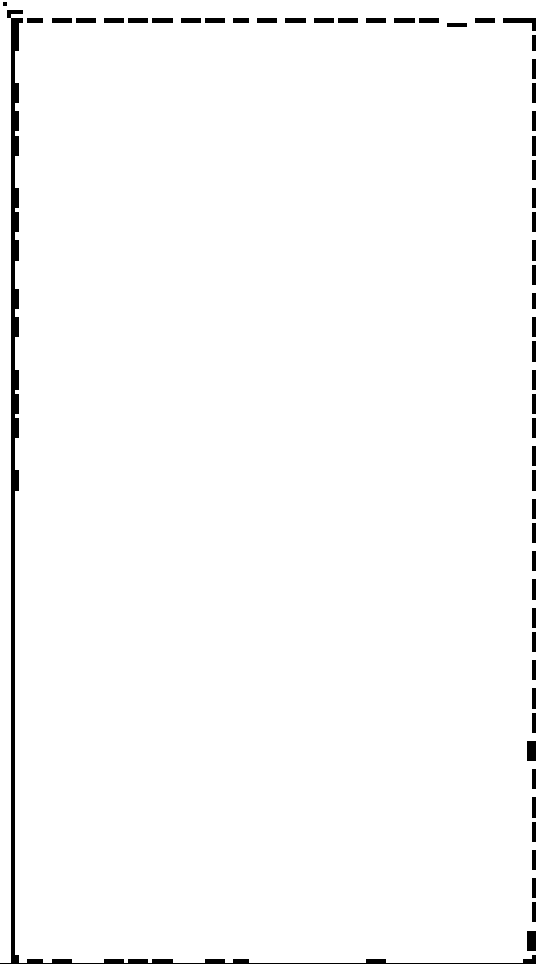
In the land of Egypt, Joseph had two sons:

Thus were all the tribes begun.

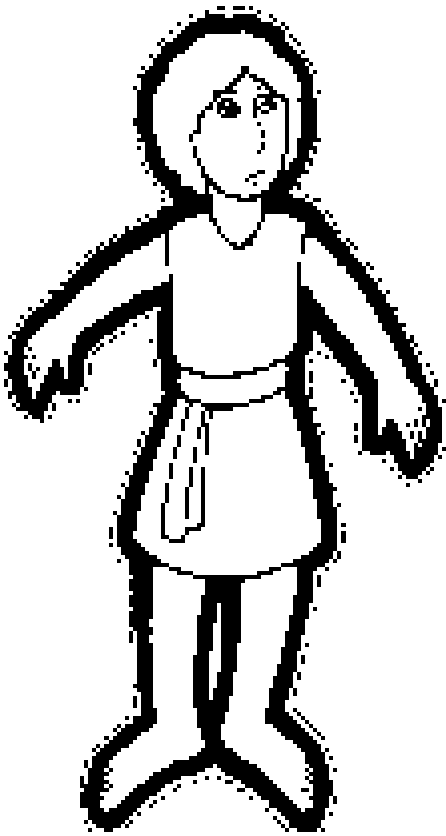
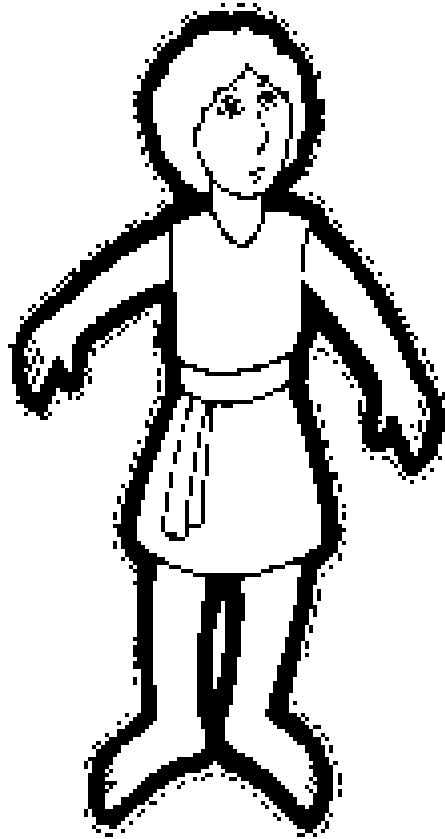
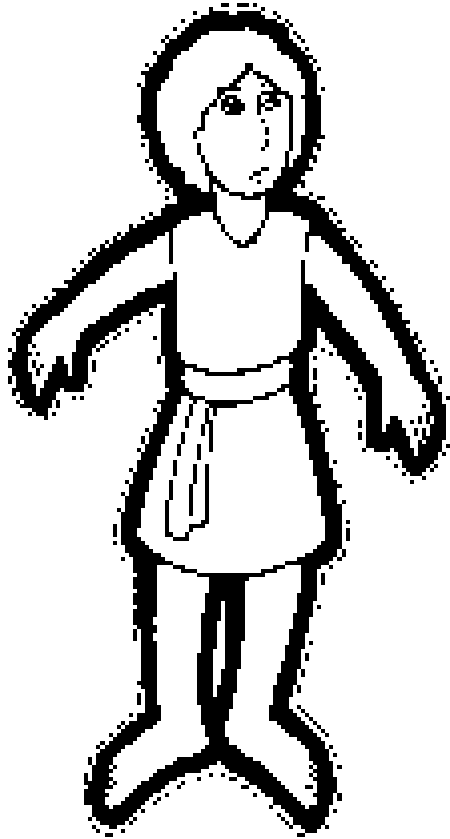


Joseph becomes Potiphar's slave in Egypt.  
Gen. 39:1-20

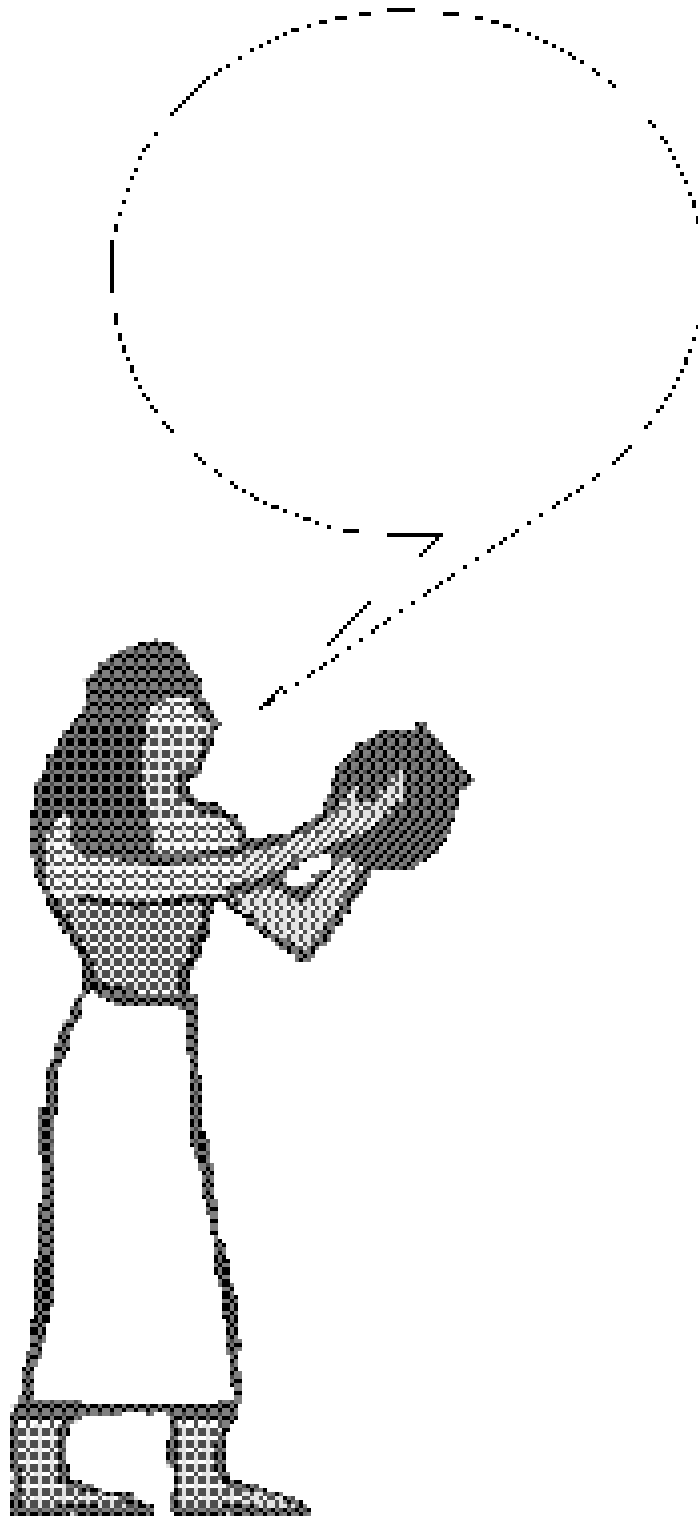


Potiphar's wife had Joseph thrown in jail.  
"The Lord was with Joseph..." Gen. 39:2

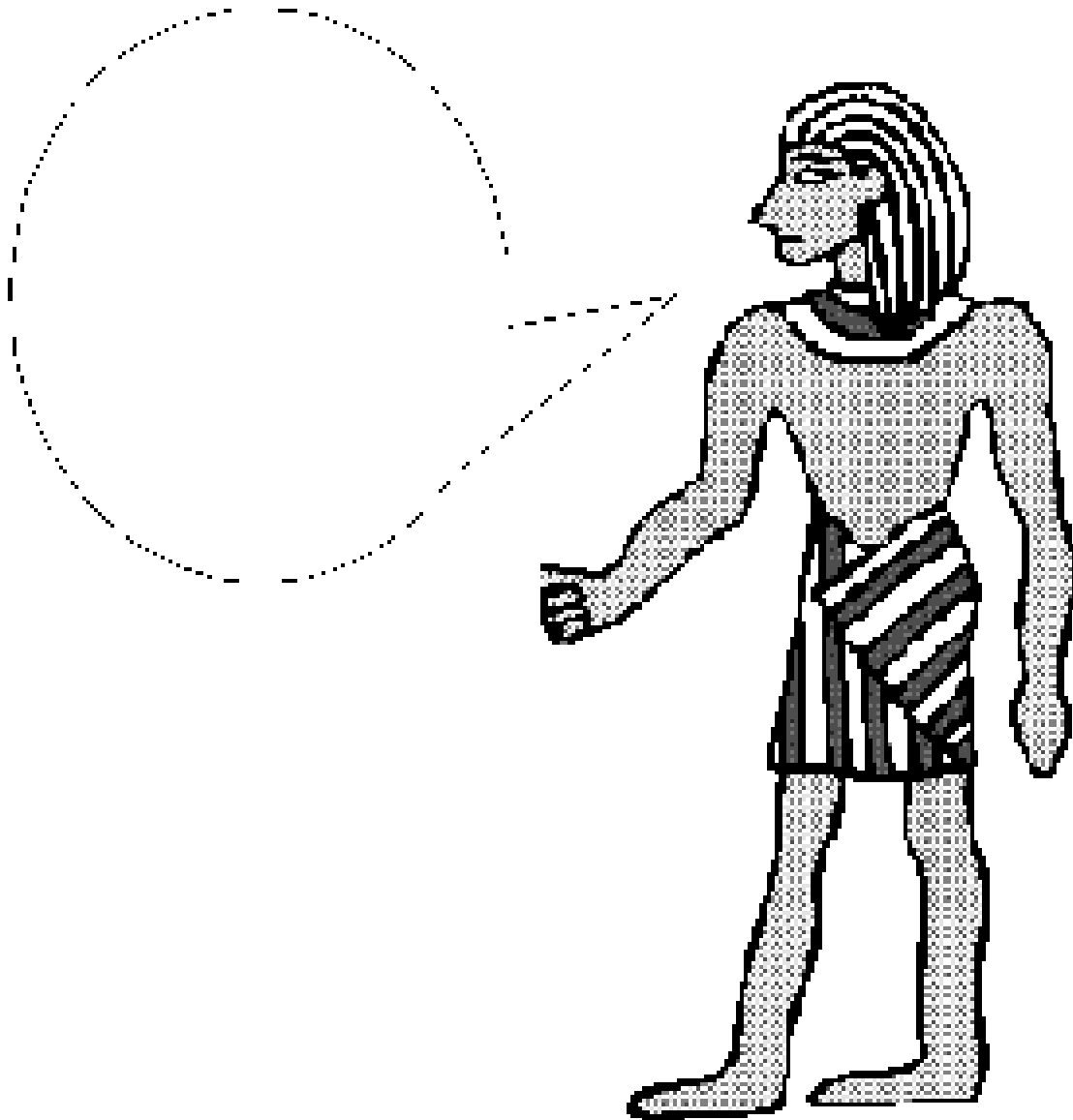


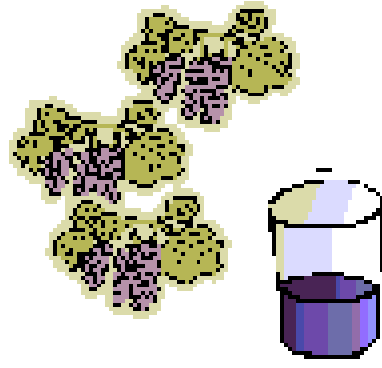
