<p>Story: Jud. 4-5</p> <p>Focus: Deborah was the 4th judge</p>	<p>Make large colored paper tree to tape to wall. Sit on the floor "under" the tree to tell the story.</p>	<p>Deborah's Message to Barak (pg 3)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut out on solid line, cut out Deborah and Barak • Fold tree down from top at an angle • Fold in half and glue into colored paper cover. • Glue Deborah under the tree.
<p>Story:</p> <p>Focus: Deborah went with Barak and the Israelite army to fight Sisera and the Hazorite army</p>	<p>Sand box</p>	<p>Deborah goes with Barak (pg 4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glue Barak and Deborah in between armies. • Fold in half and glue into colored paper cover
<p>Story:</p> <p>Focus: A woman, Jael, kills Sisera</p>		<p>Jael defeats Sisera Lift-a-flap (pg 5)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using an exacto knife cut around the sides and bottom of Jael to form a flap • Tape the picture of Jael with tent peg behind the flap • Glue inside colored paper cover
<p>Read:</p> <p>Focus: Jael was given the honor instead of Barak, just as Deborah said would happen</p>		<p>Israel Celebrates (pg 6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glue inside colored paper cover, if desired

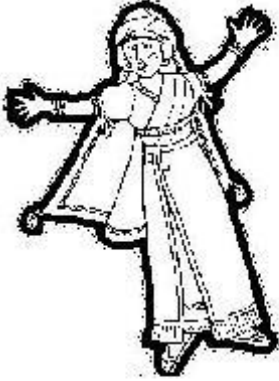

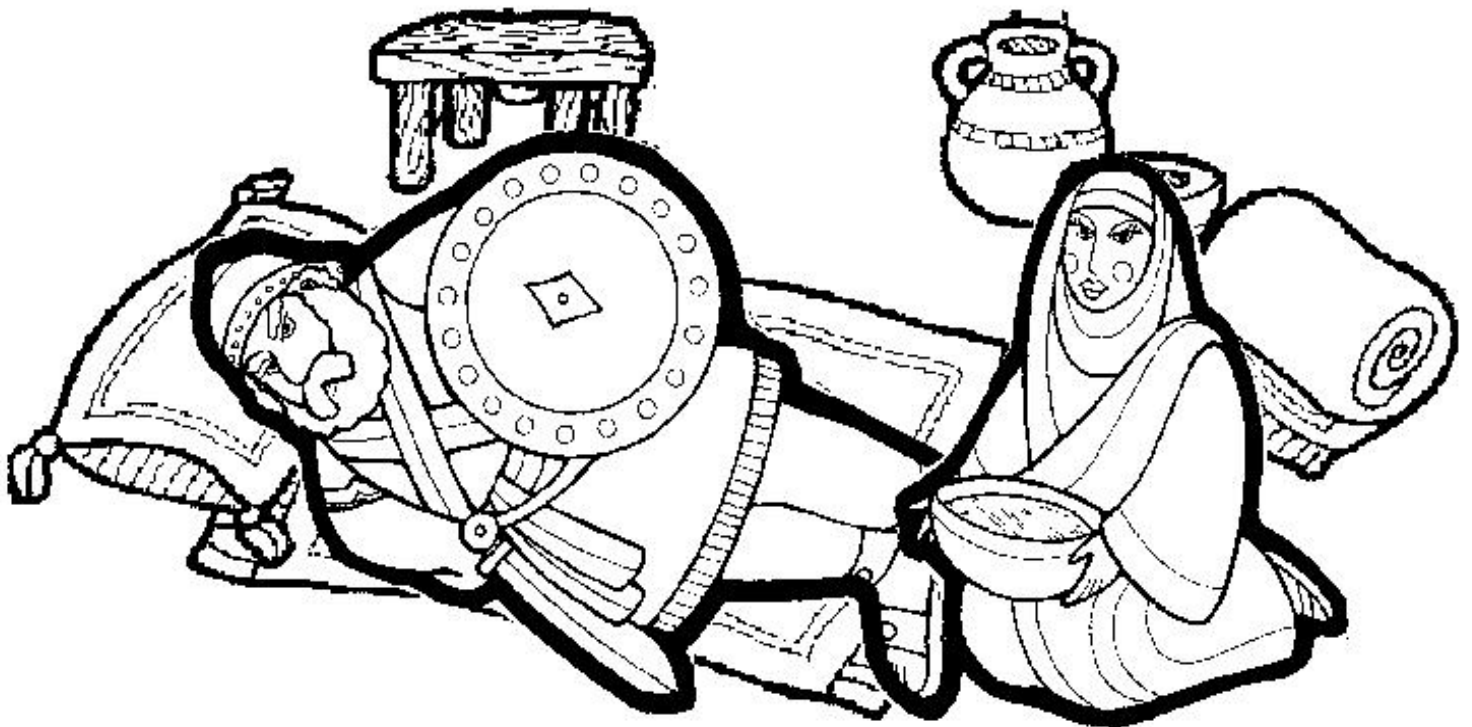
