Welcome Songs Prayer	Read: <i>Noah and the Very First Rainbow</i> Center on - God told Noah to Build and Noah obeyed	Use ark made from big box - have children "saw" "hammer" and "paint on pitch" with toy tools to build ark **1	Glue ark(use ark without center basket part from pg 3) (after coloring) to styrofoam cup - give each child 2 bead or plastic animals **2 (pg 3-4)	Put up crayons, etc. Sing songs picked by kids Attendance Chart Sing: Read Your Bible...Tip Toe, Tip Toe...

**1 Turn a refrigerator box on its side. Cut a square out the of the top of the ark and attach a smaller box over the hole. Cut a window in one side of the small box. Cut a large door from the front side of the ark and draw or paint "boards" on the front side, top and one end of the ark. Cut extra "boards" from cardboard. Use toy tools to let children to (quietly and gently) "build" ark.

**2 Make an ark basket from card stock.

**3 Glue pictures of animals on inside walls of ark before class.

**4 Use small spray bottle to make it rain on the ark.

**5 I made rainbows from Perler Activity Beads (the kind you put on peg bases and melt with an iron to create pictures) and used sticky-back magnet strips.

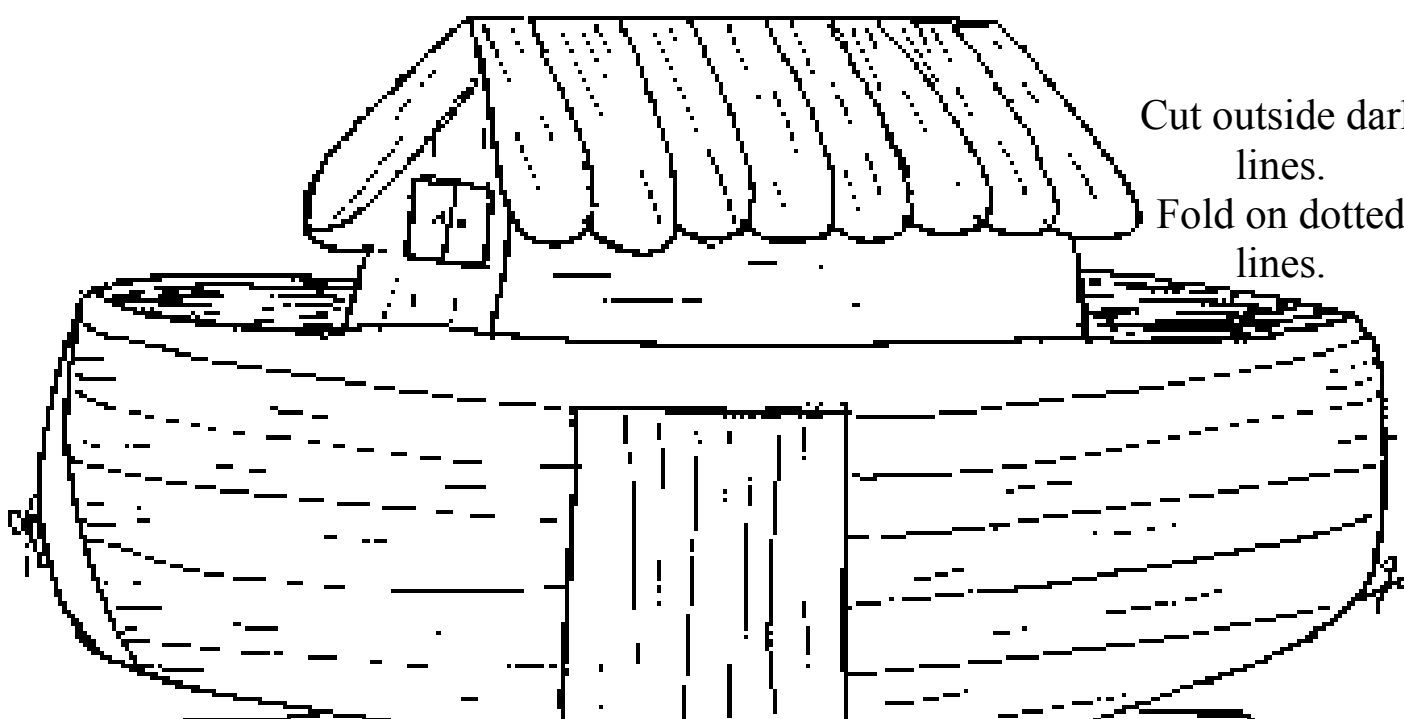

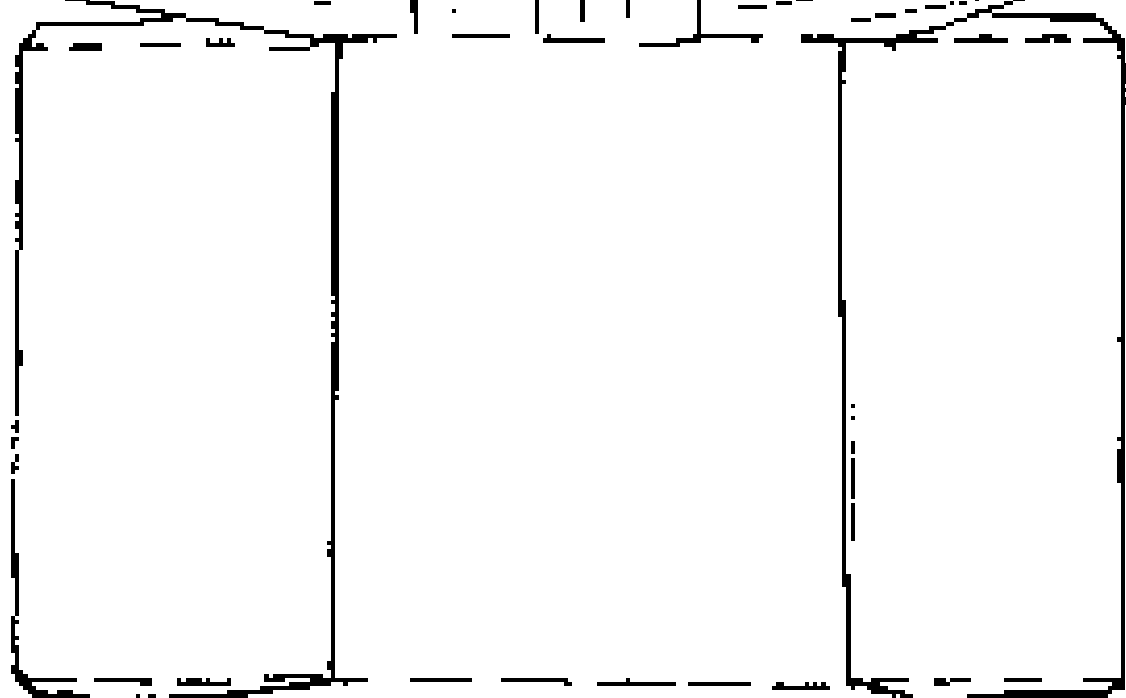

Rainbow

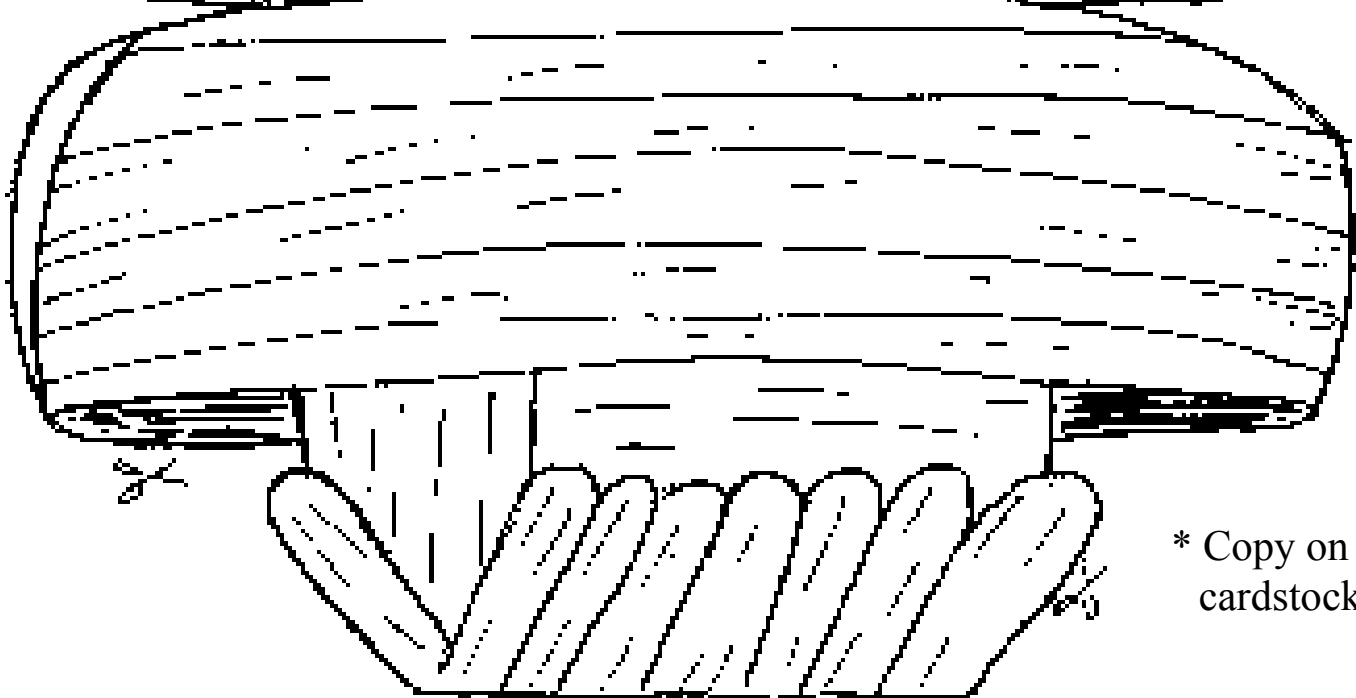
Red and yellow and pink and green,

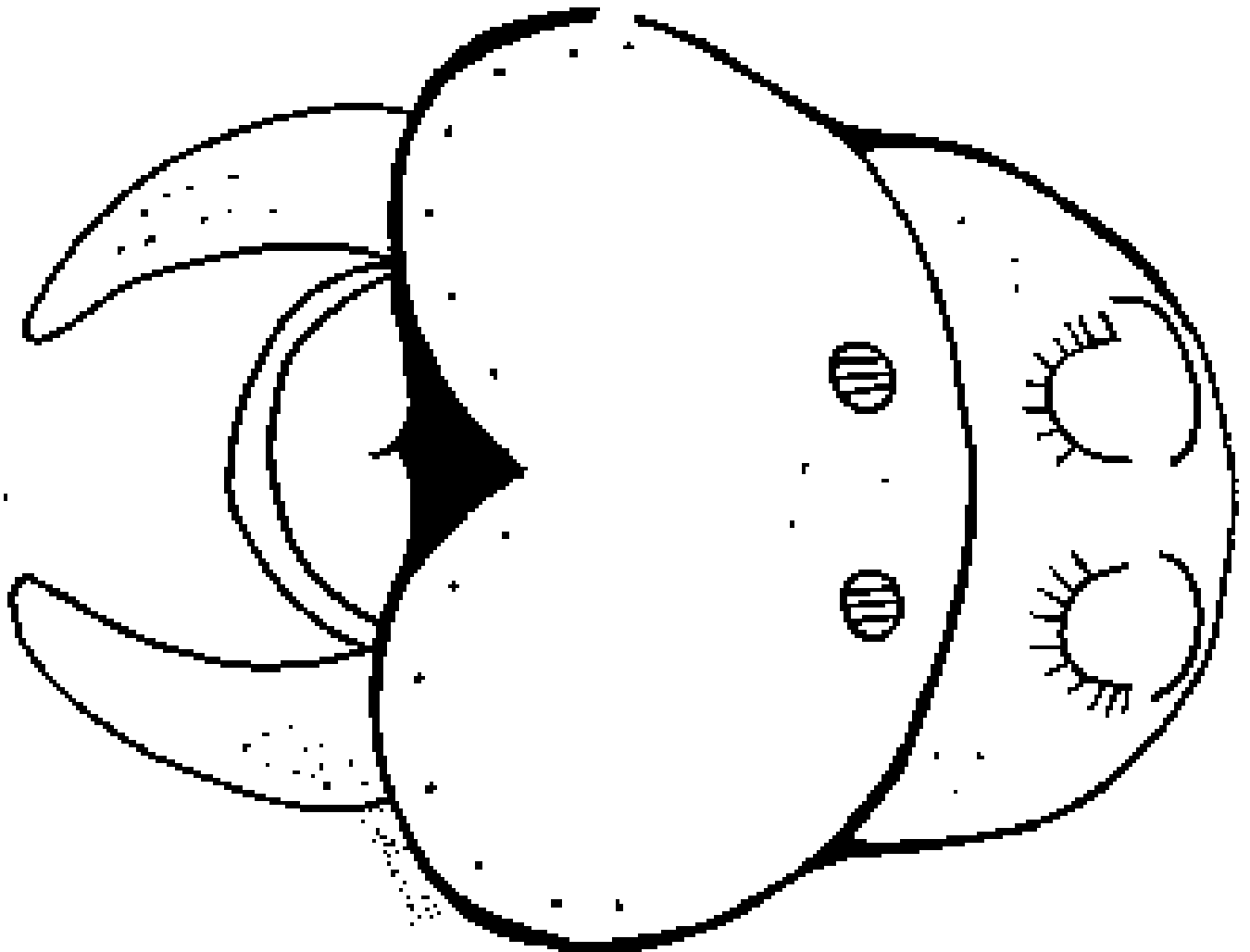
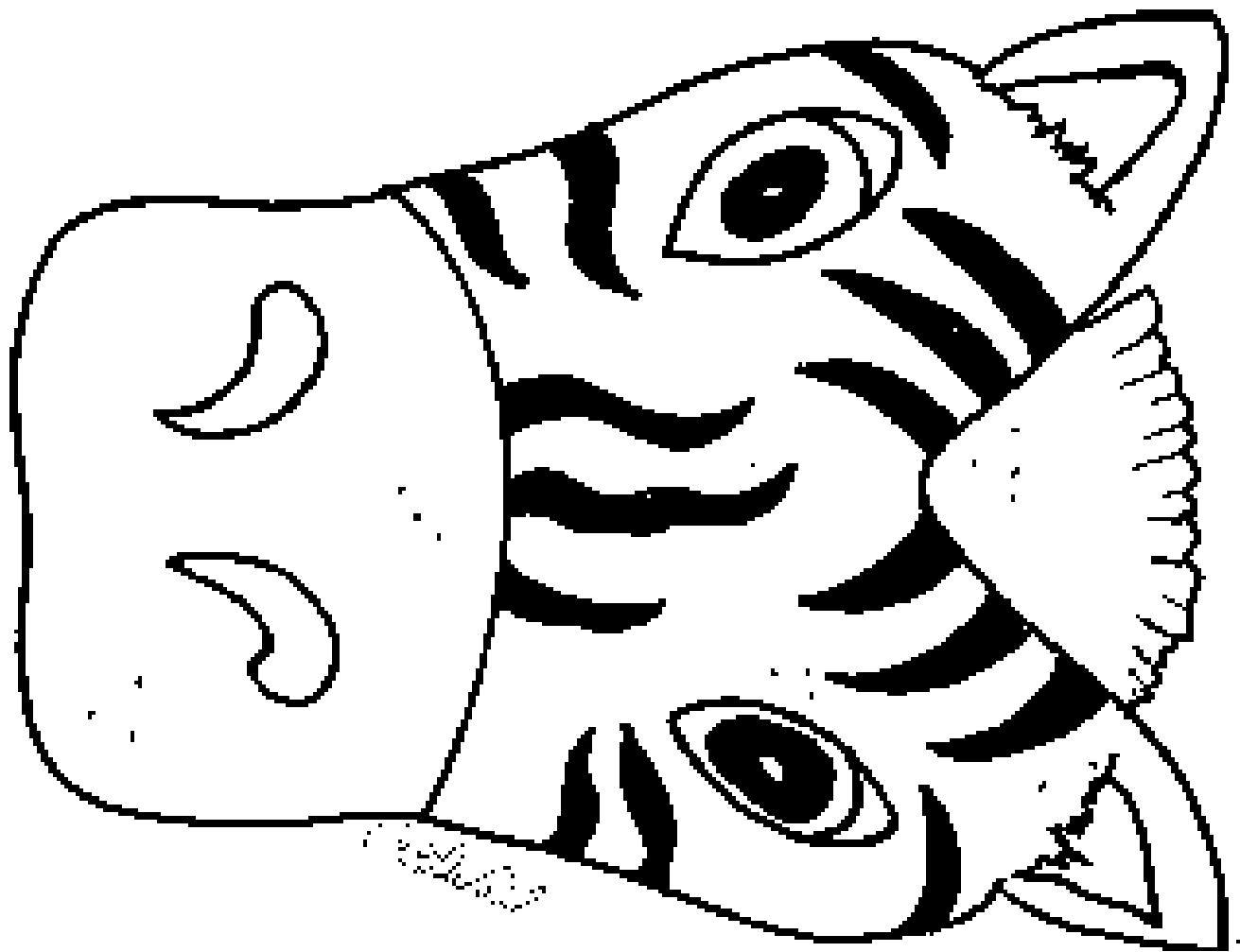
Cut outside dark lines.
Fold on dotted lines.

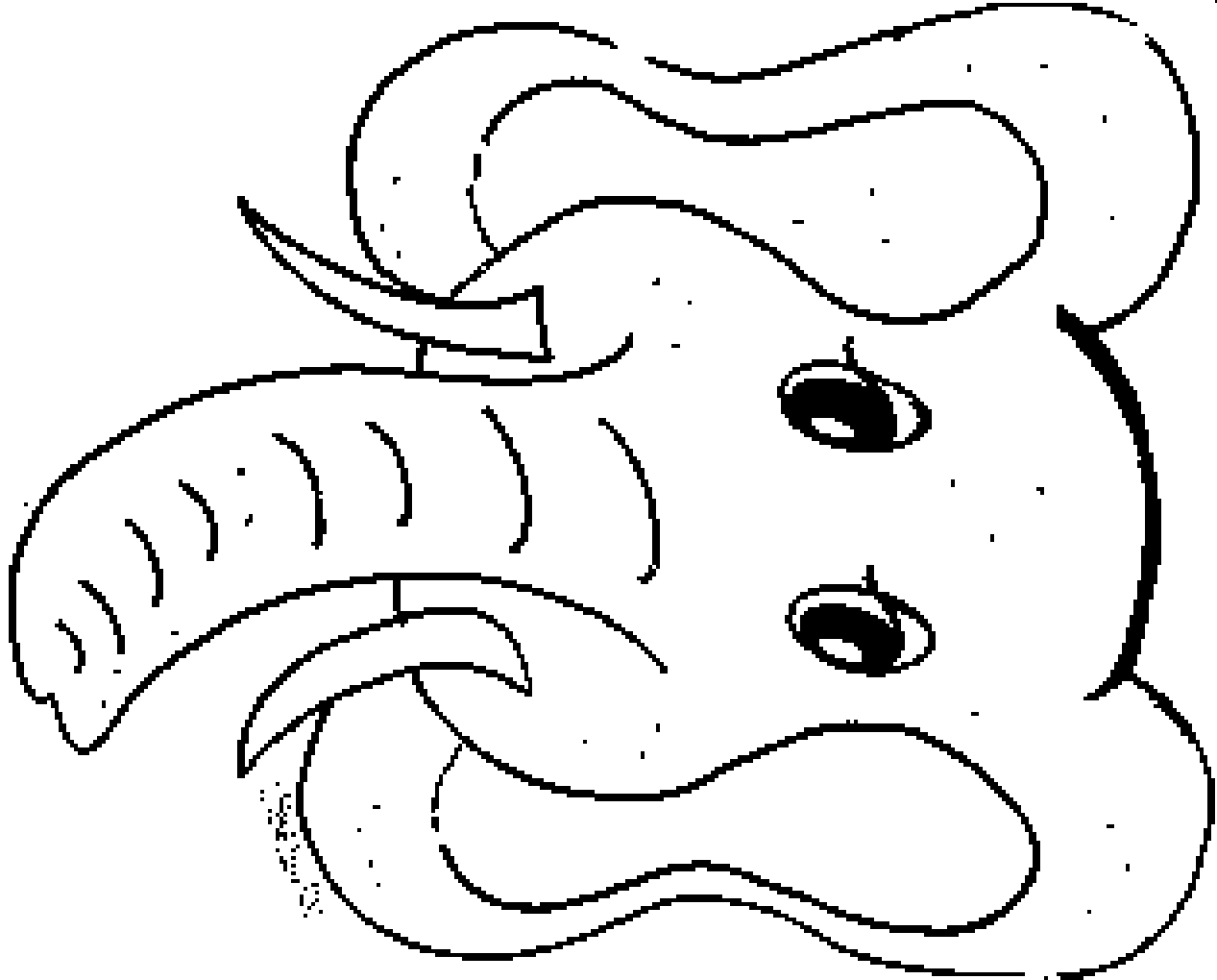
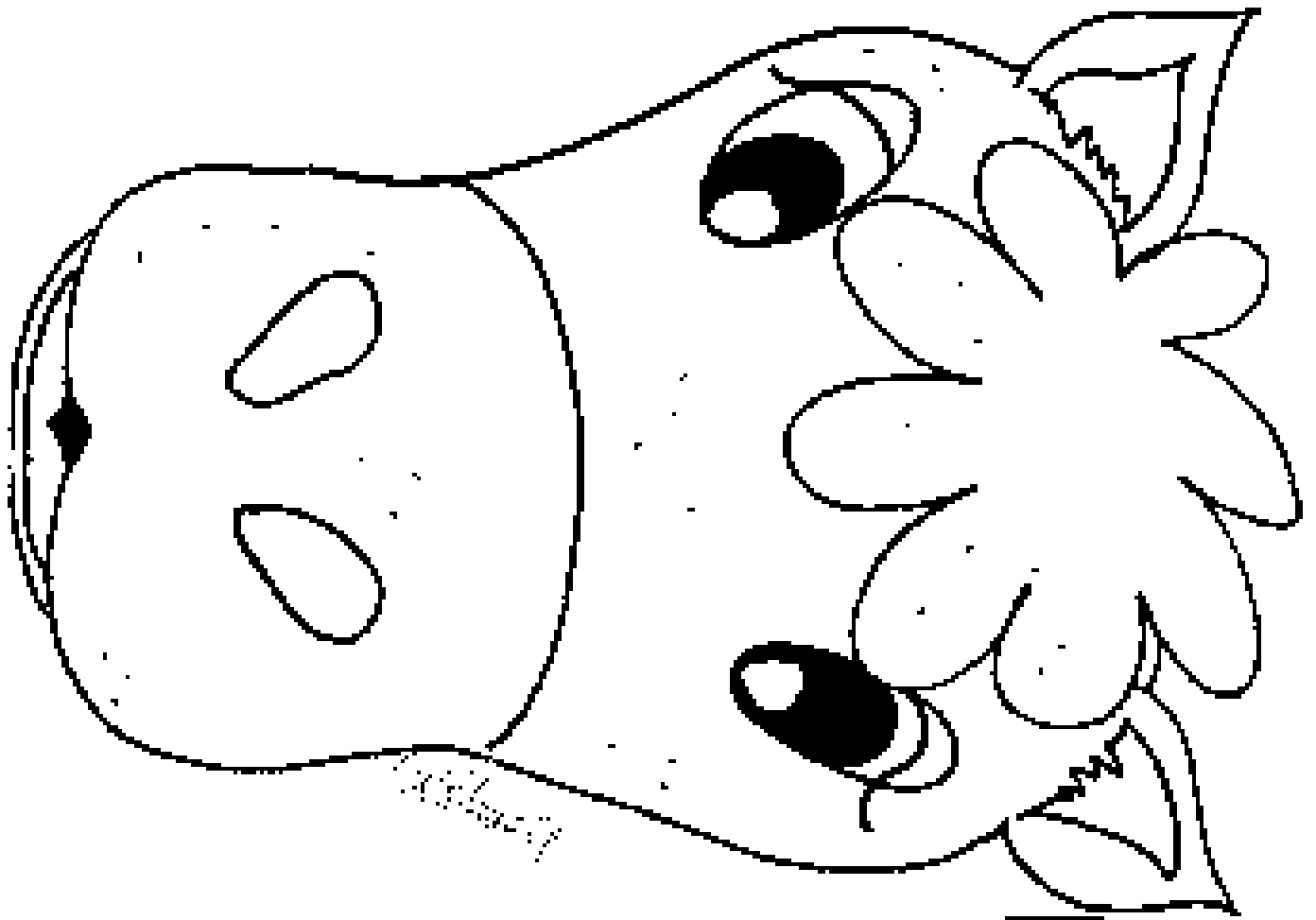


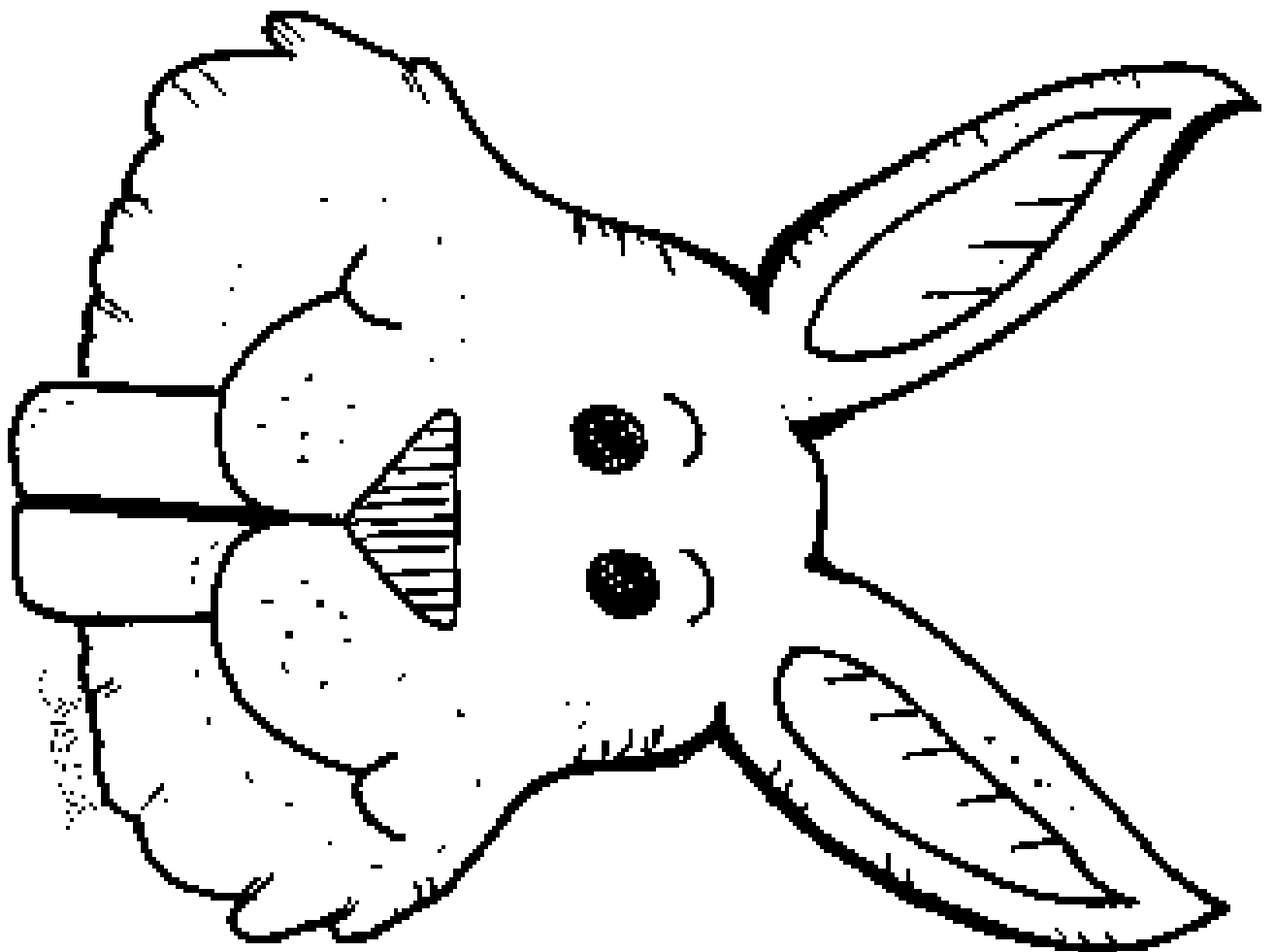
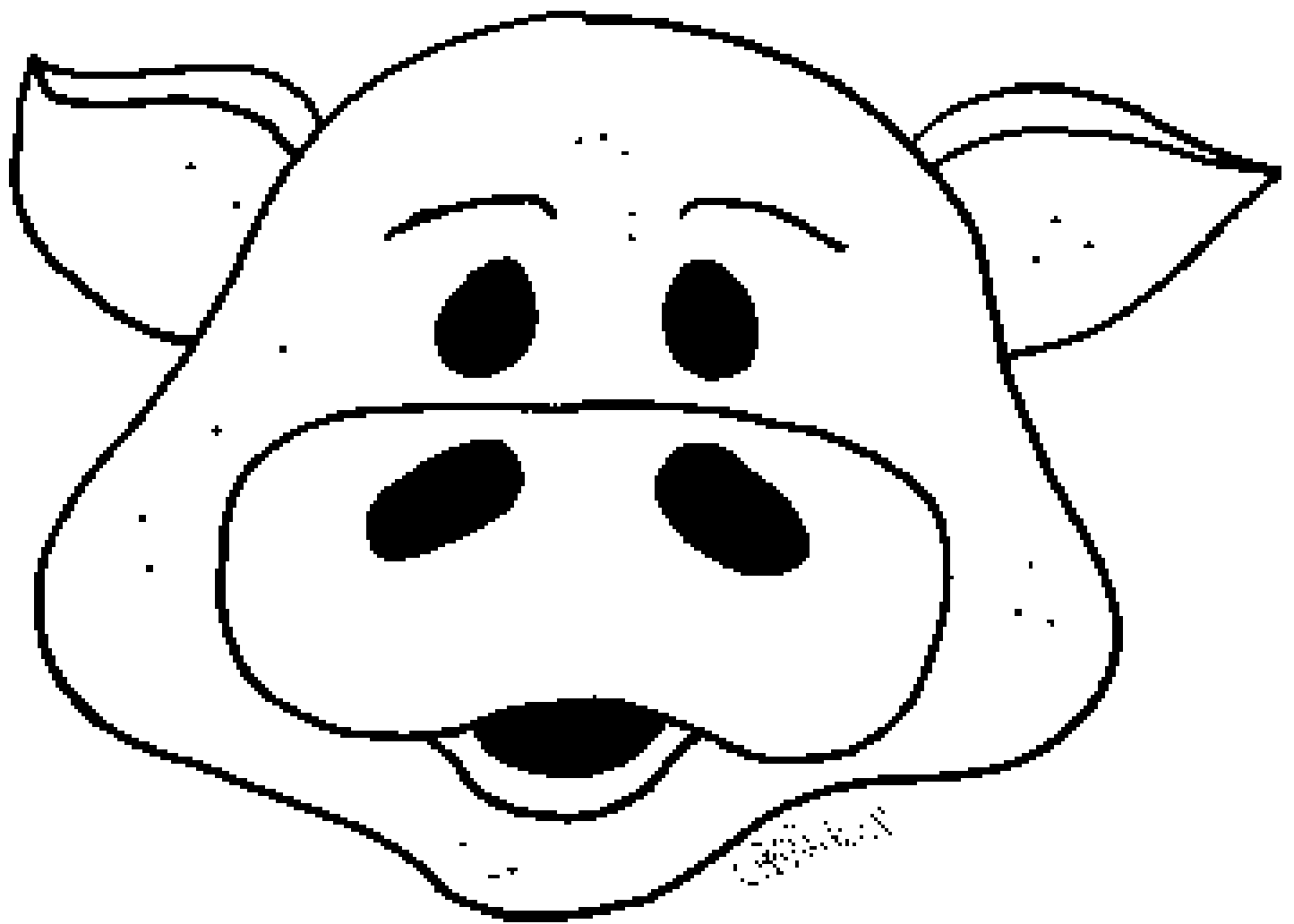
Glue tabs

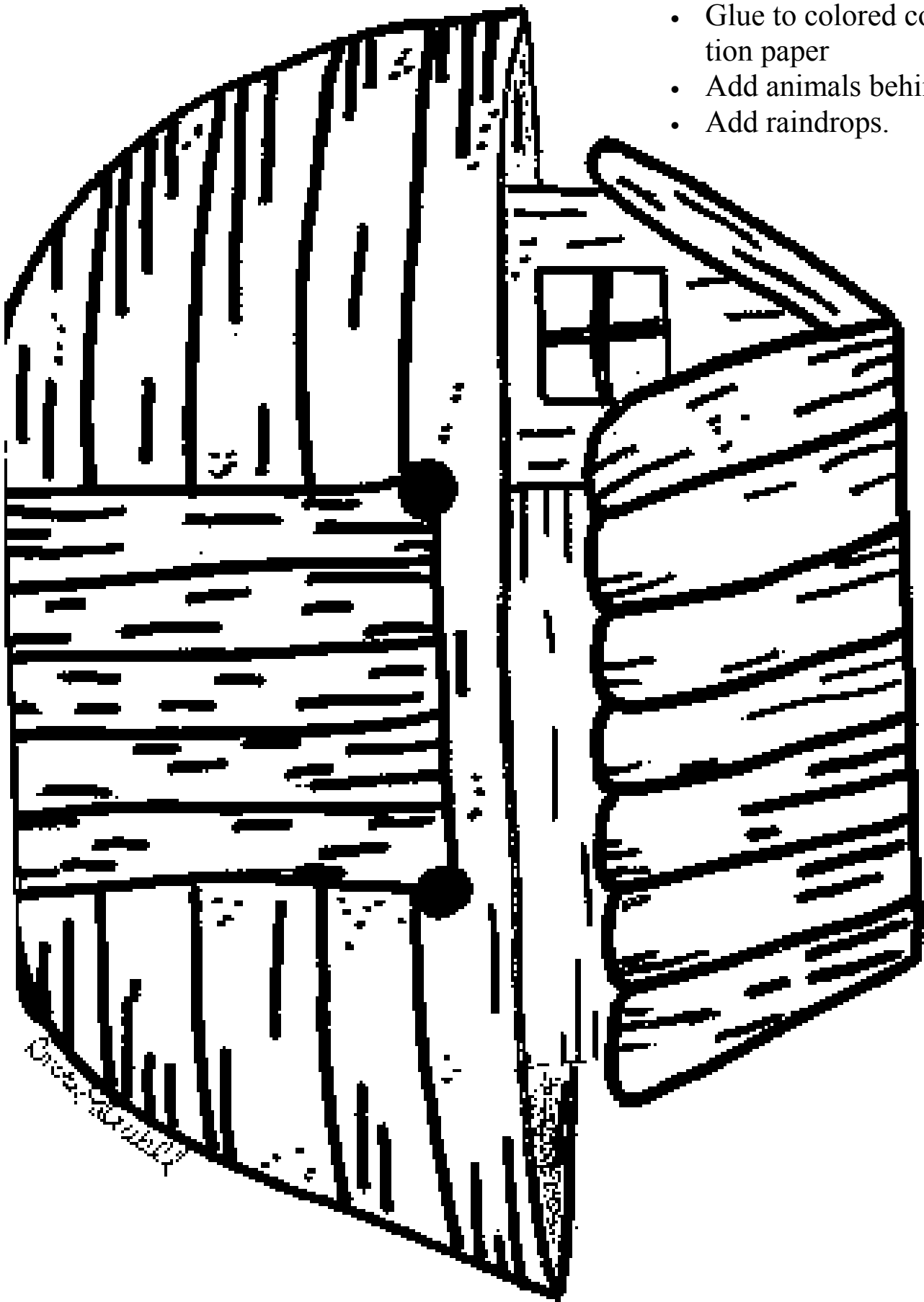

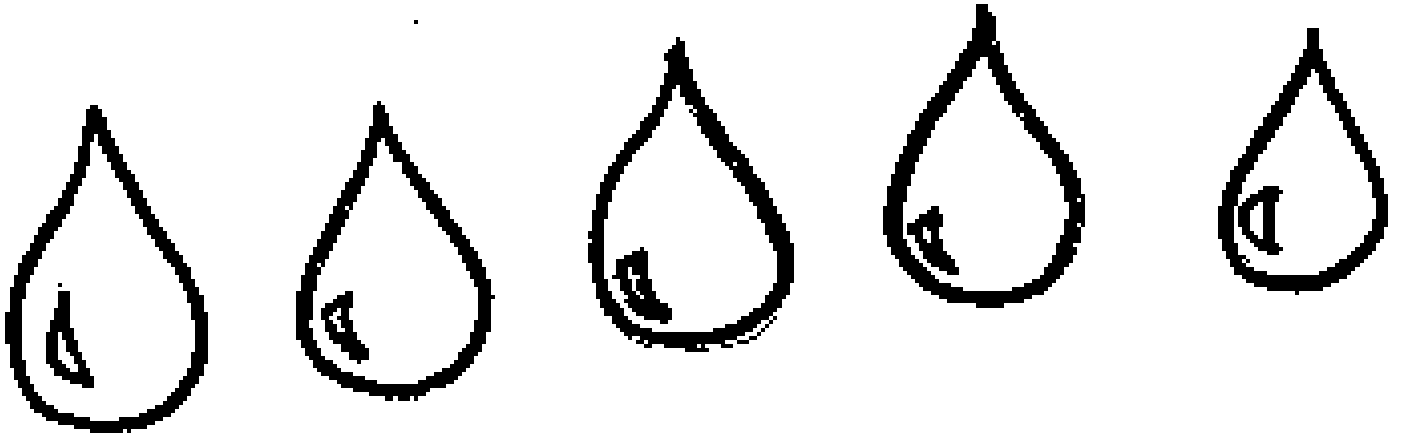
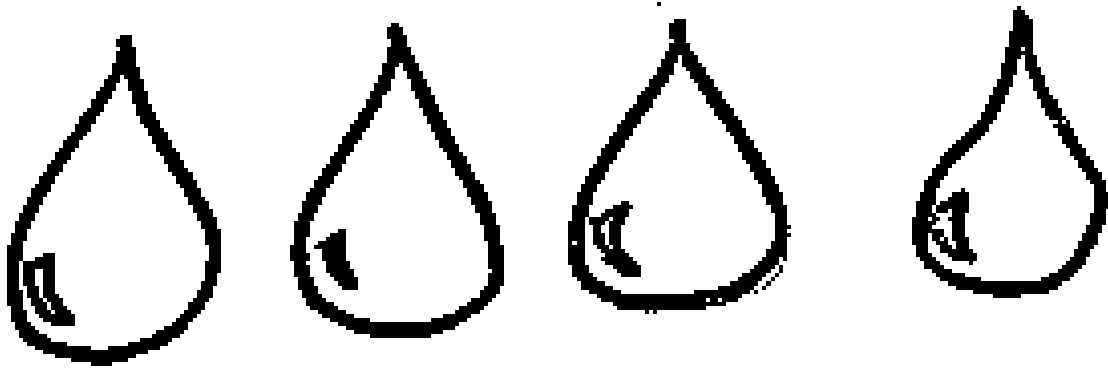




- Copy on tan paper

- Add raindrops.

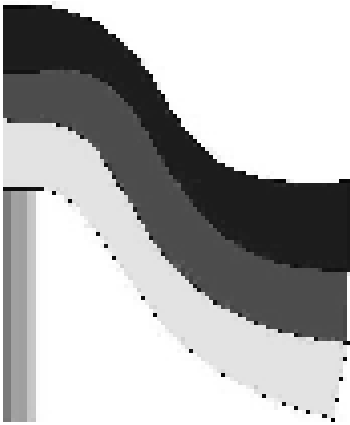


Copy on blue paper to add to front of Ark picture.

Tape colored ribbon or narrow crepe streamers around the top of a pencil.



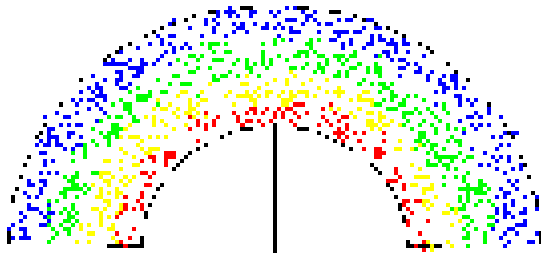

Glue a small magnet on back of Perler bead rainbow and tape to "God Keeps His Promises!" card



- cut paper plate in half, cut out middle.
- Punch a small hole at the bottom in the center.
- Cut colored tissue paper into small squares (about 1/2")
- Crumple tissue paper squares
- Cut out a dove per student

In class

- Cover paper plate with glue.
- Cover with the tissue paper squares.
- Fold dove in half and glue together with a string glued between the wings.
- Tie string to rainbow through the hole.
- Tie another string at the top to hang as a mobile, if desired.
