

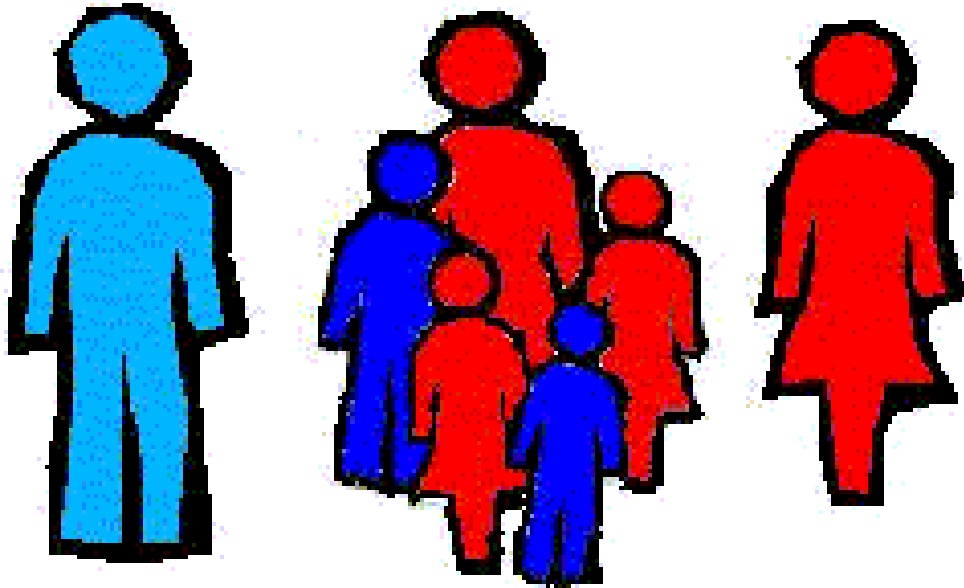

Before Class:

- Cut page in half
- Cut out figures above, make into stickers, if desired.

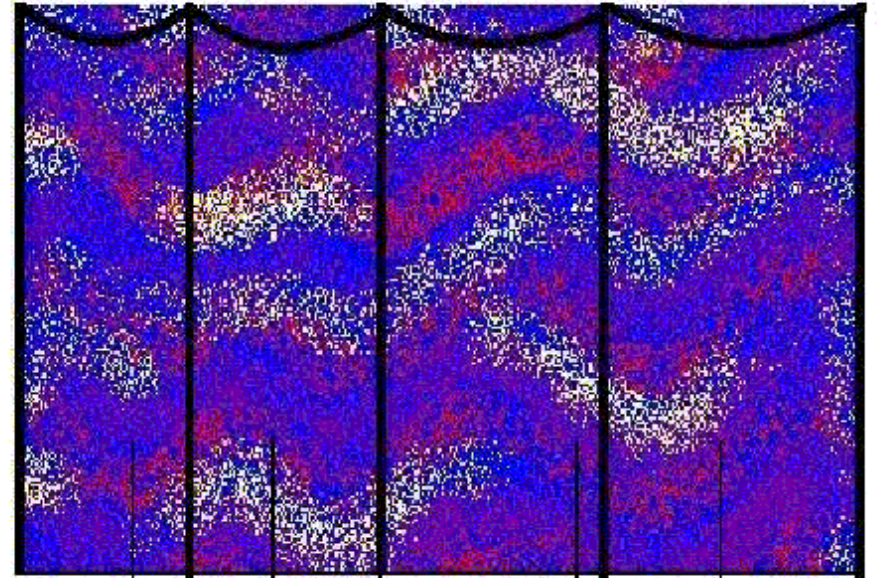
In Class:

- Give students bottom half of page.
- Have students glue/place sticker of Elkannah in the center, Peninnah and children on one side of Elkannah and Hannah on the other.

Before class:

- Cut page in half
- Cut out cover text box, "Hannah" and "Priest"
- Cut along 4 tab lines, make pop-up book, glue into construction paper cover

In class:

- Have students glue "Hannah" to the left tab and the "Priest" to the right tab
- Blue text box on front cover.
