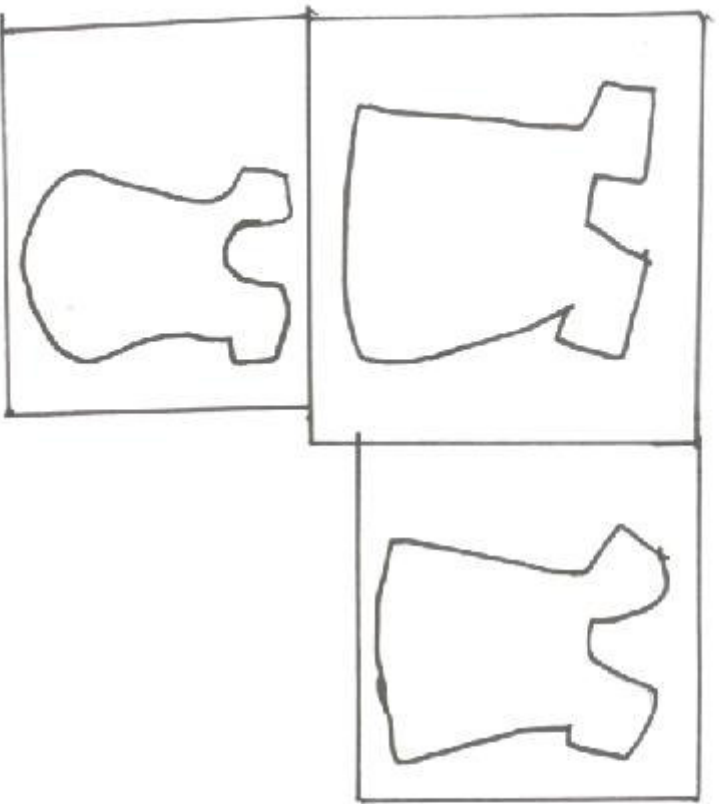
Lullaby for Samuel

go to sleep now, my son.

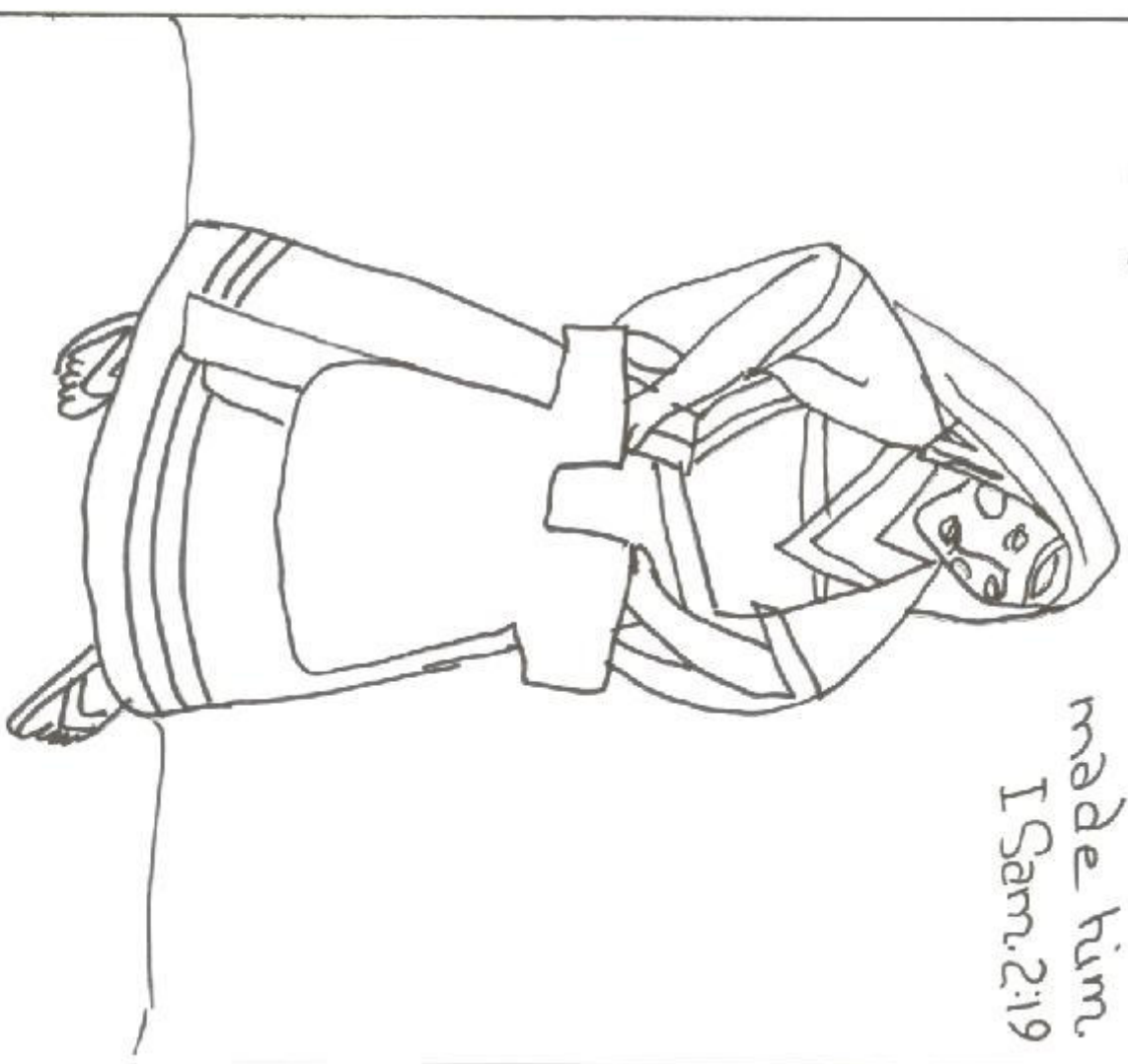
